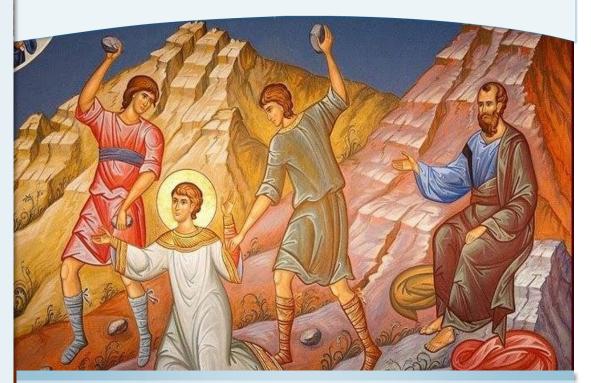

Gospel Matthew 21:33-42, The Parable of the Criminal Tenant

The Lord told this parable: "There was a man, a landowner, who planted a vineyard, and put a hedge around it, and dug a wine vat in it, and built a tower; then he leased it to the vinedressers, and went abroad. But when the fruit season drew near, he sent his servants to the vine-dressers to receive his fruits. And the vine-dressers seized his servants, and beat one. killed another, and stoned another. Again, he sent another party of servants more numerous than the first; and they did the same to these. Finally, he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.' But the vine-dressers, on seeing the son, said among themselves, 'This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and we shall have his inheritance.' So, they seized him, cast him out of the vineyard, and killed him. When, therefore, the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vine-dressers?" They said to him, "He will utterly destroy those evil men, and will lease the vineyard to other vine-dressers, who will render to him the fruits in their seasons." NEW BISHOP NAMED! AXIOS! Bishop Nicholas Samra is happy to announce that His Holiness, Pope Francis, has given his assent to the canonical election of Father Francois Beyrouti as the 6th Eparchial Bishop of Newton for the Melkite Greek Catholics in the United States. Father Francois, 51 was elected on June 23,2022, by the Melkite Synodheld at the Basilica of Santa Maria in Cosmedin, Rome, Italy. A terna (list of the nominated) of 3 names was sent to the Dicastery of the Eastern Churches and Pope Francis confirmed the election. The announcement was made on Saturday, August 20, 2022, by His Beatitude, Patriarch Joseph Absi, Patriarch of Antioch and All the East for Melkite Greek Catholics.

The schedule for the episcopal ordination and installation of the Most Rev. Francois Beyrouti is as follows:

October 12,2022 (Wednesday)

St. Anne Melkite Catholic Co-Cathedral, North Holywood, CA. 11:00 a.m. – Luncheon for all Clergy and the Beyrouti Family. 2:00 p.m. – Pontifical Divine Liturgy with Ordination of a Bishop.

A receiving line on the cathedral grounds will follow the Divine Liturgy for all those not attending the evening gala. Gratis status applies to all attending bishops, and Eparchy of Newton priests, deacons, monks, and nuns (active or retired). Clergy family members and non-Newton priests, deacons, monks, and nuns require tickets.\$75.00

October 19, 2022 (Wednesday)

Annunciation Melkite Catholic Cathedral, West Roxbury, MA (Boston) 11:00 a.m. – Luncheon for all Clergy and the Beyrouti Family. 2:00 p.m. Installation Divine Liturgy.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Presently effective, the schedule of offerings in the parishes is now: Liturgies: \$25.00; Funerals: \$300.00. Weddings: \$300.00; Baptisms: \$100.00.

Thus far, all Liturgy Offerings received from Funerals, which exceeded more than one year or even more, have had the maximum and minimum celebrations. Surplus ones have been deposited in the Building Fund, and placed on the altar and remembered collectively, similar to the customs of Spiritual Bouquets, Perpetual Mass Enrollments & Memorial Cards, as in Chapels, Shrines, & Monasteries. Your presence at Divine Liturgy has been missed, and we pray that you will all return now that the Fall Schedule begins, with full vim, vigor, and vitality.

TODAY, SEPTEMBER 4th, there will be a special collection taken up for the **UPKEEP, MAINTENANCE & IMPROVE-MENT OF THE CEMETERY.** Please be as generous as you can, and we thank you for your continued support in providing a peaceful resting place for our beloved deceased.

A LOOK AHEAD: The Church will resume its Fall Schedule of Liturgies next Sunday, September 11TH, 2022, i.e. 9:00 a.m.& 11:15 a.m. with <u>no</u> Liturgy on Saturday. Please pass on this change of hours to all relatives and friends, and to all who frequent our church from time to time.

<u>CATECHETICAL SUNDAY:</u> is an annual observance which is nationally observed this year on September 18, 2022. However, registration will take place on Sunday, September 11th after the 9::00 a.m. Liturgy in the classroom and the teachers will emphasize the importance of our teaching and learning ministry as Christians, the beginning of our religious education program.

The Annual Barbecue for the Sunday School Children and their Family will take place on Sunday, September 18th, following the Divine Liturgy.

<u>HAPPY NEW YEAR!</u> "Change the former way of life that was part of the person you once were, corrupted by deceitful desires. Instead, renew the thinking in your mind by the Spirit and clothe yourself with the new person created according to God's image in justice and true holiness."

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Traditionally referred to as Extreme Unction or Last Rites, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick was previously most commonly administered to the dying, for the remission of sins, and the provision of spiritual strength and health. In modern times, however, its use has been expanded to all who are gravely ill or are about to undergo a serious operation

The Church stresses a secondary effect of the sacrament: to help a person recover his health. Like Confession and Holy Communion, to which it is closely linked, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick can be repeated as often as it is necessary.

It is the Pastor's desire to provide the Sacraments or pastoral visits to our parishioners. Because the Federal Privacy Act HIPPA will not allow to respond if requests are made by friends or some other non-family member, it is important that the patient or a family member let the Pastor or one of the Deacons know when they are needed. When you or a family member are hospitalized or are homebound and are in need of the Sacrament of the Sick, please phone the church number at 401-722-1345 to arrange for a visit. It is also recommended that the family to inform the hospital or nursing home upon admission that the patient desires a visit from the Church.

If you anticipate a hospital stay or have a serious health problem, please ask Father Ephrem for the Sacrament following Divine Liturgy or contact the office as soon as possible. Although it is sometimes impossible to anticipate the need, waiting until the last minute could result in no priest being available or no time for the priest to arrive. Remember only a priest may provide this Sacrament as it includes remission of sin as well as healing.

The Sacrament of the Sick is a Sacrament of healing and should occur early in an illness when possible so that the patient will be able to participate in it.

O Jesus, Who has said,
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FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS, SEPTEMBER 14: According to Christian tradition, the True Cross was discovered in 326 by Saint Helena, the mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine the Great, during a pilgrimage she made to Jerusalem. The Church of the Holy Sepulchre was then built at the site of the discovery, by order of Helena and Constantine. The Church was dedicated nine years later, with a portion of the cross. One-third remained in Jerusalem, one-third was brought to Rome and deposited in the Sessorian basilica Santa Croce in Gerusaemme (Holy Cross in Jerusalem), and one-third was taken to Constantinople to make the city impregnable.

Important: This year, the Divine Liturgy will be elaborately celebrated on the actual day, Wednesday, September 14th at 6:30 p.m. in the Church with the distribution of blessed carnations. At the end, we will all file outside to the front of the Church around the center island.

3 Fire pits will be set up on the island and a special so-called bon fire will be lit and will be explained to you during the homily In Church that evening. This is a first historical event of preserving our heritage and liturgical tradition in our Parish for this Feast. We can't stress enough, encourage and urge you to attend the entire Celebration. At the end of this service, you are all cordially invited to proceed to the Cultural Center for refreshments, where we can greet each other.

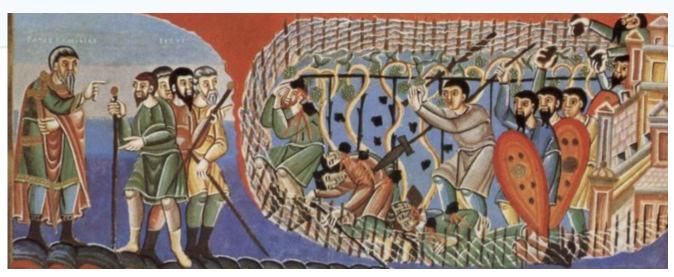

يسرد يسوع المسيح مثل الكرَّامِينَ القتلة في الهيكل مخاطبًا عظماء الكهنة وشيوخ الشعب بعد دُخُولُه المهيب إلى أورشليم، ولخُص فيه تاريخ الخلاص كلَّه في هذا المثل حيث يظهر شخصيات رئيسية، وهي: رب البيت هو الله، والكرْم هم بنو إسرائيل، والكرَّامون هم القادة الدينيون في إُسْرَائَيْل، وَخُدُّم رَّبِ النَّبِيتَ هُمَ الأنبيَّاء، وَابن رَّبَ البيِّت يسوّع الْمسيح، والآخرون وهم الأمم الوثنية والبقية من اليهود.

What is the meaning of the Parable of the Vineyard?



Background: There are 6 main characters in this parable: 1) the landowner—God, 2) the vineyard—Israel, 3) the tenants/farmers—the Jewish religious leadership, 4) the landowner's servants—the prophets who remained obedient and preached God's word to the people of Israel, 5) the son—Jesus, and 6) the other tenants—the Gentiles. The imagery used is similar to Isaiah's parable of the vineyard (it would be prudent to study this also) found in Isaiah chapter 5. The watchtower and the wall mentioned in verse 33 are means of protecting the vineyard and the ripened grapes. The winepress is obviously for stamping out the juice of the grapes to make the wine. The farmer was apparently away at the time of harvest and had rented the vineyard to the tenants. This was customary of the times, and he could expect as much as half of the grapes as payment by the tenants for use of his land.

Explanation: Verses 34-36 tell us the landowner sent his servants to collect his portion of the harvest and how they were cruelly rejected by the tenants; some were beaten, stoned, and even killed. Then he sent even more the second time and they received the same treatment. The servants sent represent the prophets that God had sent to His people/ Israel and then were rejected and killed by the very people who were claiming to be of God and obedient to Him. Jeremiah was beaten (Jeremiah 26:7-11; 38:1-28), John the Baptist was killed (Matthew 14:1-12), and others were stoned (2 Chronicles 24:21). In this parable Jesus is not only reminding the religious establishment what they were like, but He was putting in their minds a question: how could they claim obedience as God's people and still reject His messengers? We don't know how many servants the owner sent, but that is not what is important; the theme is God's repeated appeal through His prophets to an unrepentant people. In the next verses (37-39), the situation becomes even more critical.

The landowner sends his own son, believing that they will surely respect him. But the tenants see an opportunity here; they believe that if they kill the son they will then receive his inheritance. The law at the time provided that if there were no heirs then the property would pass to those in possession (possession is nine tenths of the law). This amounts to conspiracy to commit murder by the Jewish leadership, and it is prophetic in the sense that Jesus is now telling them what they are going to do to Him (see Psalm 118:22; Isaiah 28:16). After Jesus' death, Peter would make the same charges against the religious establishment (Acts 4:8-12). The tenants probably thought that the fight for the

property was over, but it wasn't; the owner would now appear on the scene.

The key to understanding this parable and what it says about the religious leaders is found in verse 43, where Jesus makes their lack of obedience personal. Jesus tells the leaders that because of their disobedience they will be left out of the kingdom of heaven (individually and as a people); that they have let their opportunity for the time being slip away to be given to the Gentiles (see verse 41, "other tenants"). This will be more than they can tolerate, as we will see in verses 45 and 46. He is saying that there will be a new people of God made up of all peoples who will temporarily replace the Jews so that Jesus can establish His church. This will change the way God deals with man, from the old dispensation of the law to a new dispensation of God's grace. It will usher in a period of time where man will no longer understand forgiveness of sins as man's work through what he does or doesn't do or by the sacrifices of animals on the altar, but by the work of Christ on the cross. It will be a time where each individual can have a personal and saving relationship with the One and only God of the universe. The exciting part of the verse is the phrase "who will produce fruit"; this gives authority to the church to share the gospel of Christ to the lost of the world. Up to this time, the Jews felt that they had automatic membership in God's kingdom because of their relationship to Abraham; this is why they put so much emphasis on genealogies. But the new people of God would truly have what God wanted for Israel all along: a personal and holy relationship that would be honored through the spreading of God's word to all peoples (see Exodus 19:5-6).

Application: We apply this parable to our lives by asking two questions; first, have you come to know Christ as your Lord and Savior, or have you rejected Him like the Jewish leadership did? The process is simple, as long as you are sincere in seeking a relationship with Christ. You need to recognize your sins, and then accept Christ as the only One who can save you from the penalty of your sins. Second, if you are a believer, what have you done with Jesus? Are you like the bad tenants, rejecting His Word and living a life of disobedience? If you are, you need to study God's Word and pray for guidance, seeking His will for your life and living out that will as best as you can, moment by moment, day by day.

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells the parable of the vineyard that was leased out to tenants. When the owner's servants came to collect the

pay, the tenants beat them. When the owner sent his son, they killed the son because they thought they would be able to take the vineyard if the son was dead.

This story is about God's people. For hundreds of years God cared for His people, leaving leaders in charge. But when He sent His Son Jesus,

the leaders did not respect Him. In fact, they killed Him on the cross! God's people were like the vineyard and the leaders were like the tenants who killed the son.

In a way your life is like a vineyard too. God has given it to you and cared for you all your life. When God wants you to do something for Him, you have the choice of doing what He asks or being like the bad tenants and refusing. Whenever we don't do what is

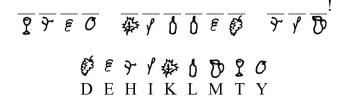
right, we are offending Jesus. But you don't want to be like those bad tenants, do you? Make sure that everything you do is for God!

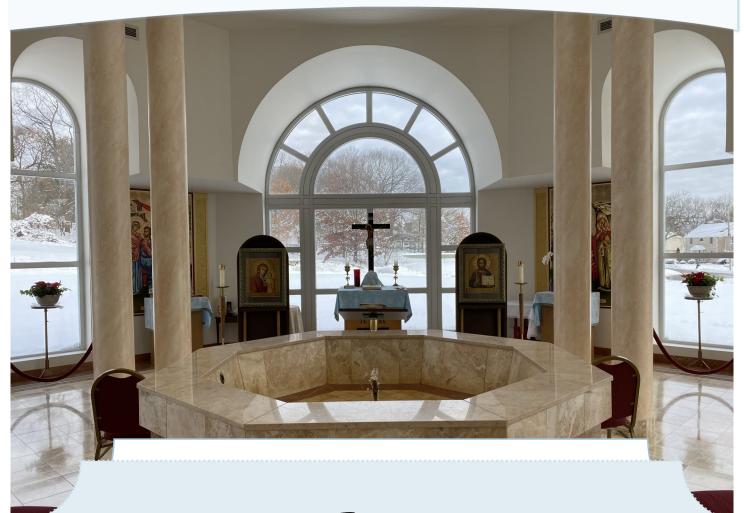

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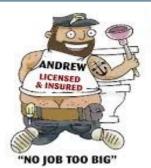
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
