<u>SAINT ELIAS, JULY 20: Read St. Luke 4:16-32:</u> St. Elias is the same person as the Hebrew Propheet Elijah; "Elias" is the way the Greek writers of the New Testament wrote the Hebrew name "Elijah". Elijah was one of the great spiritual lleaders of the Hebrew people, and both he and his disciple Elisha were held in high regard by the people to whom Jesus preached. In the gospel read at the Liturgy on this day, Jesus makes mention of both these Prophets, for their mission to the people of their day was much like his own to his people.

Elijah was famous for for his wisdom and wonderful spiritual knowledge; he did marvelous things through the power of God, healing the sick and helping the poor, and not hesitating to tell even kings wherein lay their durty to God. Elijah was regarded as a fore-runner and prototype of the Messiah, and some the Jews even thought that Jesus was he come back to life.(St. Matthew 16:14). Much of what Elijah did was regarded as a fore-telling of what the Messiah would do ehen he came, and the things Jesus did were explained in the light of what had gone before.

Elijah is rightly held in reverence for his great morall earnestness, and for the great devotion he had to the one true God, which caused him to fight all his life against evil and error. Elijah lived in Syria about 850 years before Christ was born.

He is known as the Patron and Blessing of the Vehicles and Cars!

معجزة إشباع الجموع



يتحدث المقطع الإنجيلي اليوم عن معجزة إشباع الخمسة آلأف، القراءة الإنجيلية من متى (14: 14- 22). إن رقم خمسة في الكتاب المقدّس هو عدد رمزي، الرقم 5 يرمز إلى نعمة الله، إلى الخير والبركة تُجاه البشر. إن كتب موسى في العهد القديم كانت خمسة أيضاً. بسبب في عَوْز وحاجة والتي هي ههنا في هذه الحالة إطعام الجموع. يقول القديس يوحنا الذهبي أهمية هذه المعجزة فهي مذكورة في الأناجيل الأربعة عند مرقس (6: 30- 44) و لوقا (الفم: " في هذه المعجزة يسوع كان يعلمهم التواضع، القناعة والإحسان وأن يُفكروا ببعضـهم 9: 10- 17) والإنجيلي يوحنا (6: 1- 14).

> من بعد استشهاد القديس يوحنا المعمدان أخبر يسوع بذلك فانصرف بالسفينة إلى موضع خلاء منفرداً على شاطىء بحيرة طبرية من الجهة الشمالية. لقد اعتاد الربّ يسوع الذهاب إلى موضع خلاء " للصلاة ". يظهر في إنجيل متّى أن يسوع انفرد ليُصلِّي قبل وبعد معجزة إشباع الخمسة آلآف (متىّ 14: 13 و 14: 23). لقد أعطى الربّ درساً لتلاميذه في أهمية الصلاة قبل وبعد إتمام أي عمل.

> وعندما علمت الجموع بذلك " تبعوه مشاة من المدن ". لقد أحبّت الجموع تعاليم يسوع فقصدته عندما علمت بمكانه. لقد اجتمعوا حوله كما يجتمع القطيع حول " الراعي الصالح ليقودهم في أرض خصبة. لقد قضى الشعب معظم يومه يستمع لكلام يسوع وتعاليمه الخلاصية. مضى النهار " وكان المساء ". لم يشعر الشعب والتلاميذ بمرور الوقت بسبب عذوبة كلام الربّ وحلاوة حضوره والمكوث بجانبه، " وكان الجميع يتعجبّون من كلمات النعمة الخارجة من فمه "(لوقا 4: 22).

> يبدأ المقطع الإنجيلي حينما يسوع : " أبصر جمعاً كثيراً فتحنّن عليهم وأبرأ مرضــاهم". هو الآب الرحوم الشفوق " أبو الرأفة وإله كل تعزية "(2كور 1: 3). إن هذه الصورة هي صورة مسيانية للربّ يسوع إذ أنه حسب أشعيا فإن المسيّا المُنتظر هو الذي يشفي ويُعزّي شعب الله " أحزاننا حملها وأوجاعنا تحملها " (أشعيا 53: 4).

> لقد طلب التلاميذ من الربّ يسوع قائلين:"المكان قفر والساعة قد فاتت فاصرف الجموع ليذهبوا إلى القرى ويبتاعوا طعاماً". ربما لم يخطر على بالهم أن الربّ يسوع سوف يهتم بحاجاتهم الجسدية كما أنه تحنّن عليهم وأبرأ مرضاهم. ها هو يُظهر حنانه مُجدّداً ويهتم بحاجاتهم الجسدية ليُشبع جوعهم فيقول للتلاميذ: " أعطوهم أنتم ليأكلوا". فكان جواب التلاميذ: " ما عندنا ههنا إلا خمسة أرغفة وسمكتان". لقد أراد الربّ بهذا الطلب أن يسترعي انتباه تلاميذه إلى أن الطعام المتوافر لا يكفي لهذا العدد الكبير فهو كان يُحضّر هم للمعجزة التي كان مُزمِعاً أن يُحققها. لقد تحنّن أولاً على الجمع وأبرأ مرضاهم ثم أشبعهم من الطعام، هو المُهتم بالخليقة وبحاجات الإنسان الروحية والمادية.


لقد أراد بهذا الطلب أن يُريهم صعوبة تحقيق هذا الأمر بالطريقة البشرية وليُريهم أنه هو ابن الله. لقد أراد الربّ يسوع أن يُظهر لتلاميذه أمران: أولاً، أهمية المُشاركة ومُساعدة من هم البعض وأن يتشاركوا كل شيء فيما بينهم". ثانياً، أراد أن يُريهم أن سبب تحقيق هذه المعجزة هو الحاجة والضرورة وليس المجد الباطل.

عندما أدرك التلاميذ صعوبة واستحالة إشباع هذه الجموع من الخمسة أرغفة والسمكتان تدخِّل يسوع قالاً لهم:" هلم بها إليَّ إلى هنا". ثم " أخذ الخمسة الأرغفة والسمكتين ونظر الى السماء، وبارك وكسر وأعطى الأرغفة لتلاميذه والتلاميذ للجموع". لقد رأت الكنيسة المقدسة في هذه الأفعال التي صنعها الربّ يسوع: "أخذ، نظر، بارك وكسر وأعطى" صورة مُسبقة لسرّ الشكر الإلهي أو "الأفخارستيا".

لقد نظر يسوع إلى السماء كما يقول الذهبي الفم " لكي يُظهر لنا أنه مُرسَل من الله الآب وأنـه أيضاً مساو له ". لقد كان هذا الفعل من أجل تعليمنا أن لا نتناول الطعام حتى نعطى الشكر لله الذي أعطانا هذا الطعام". أما القديس كيرلس الأسكندري فيقول: "حتى يُعرَف السيّد بأنه هو الله بالطبيعة، هو كثِّر ما كان قليلاً، لقد نظر نحو السماء كما لو كان يطلب البركة من العلو. لقد صنع هذا بفعل التدبير الإلهي. من أجلنا لأنه هو نفسه الذي يملء كل الأشياء ويُباركها هو البركة الحقيقية النازلة من فوق من عند الآب. ولكنه فعل هذا حتى نتعلم منه عندما نُحظُر مائدة الطعام ونُحضّر الخبزات ونستعد لكسر الخبز أن نُحضرها نحو الله بأيدي مرفوعة وننظر إلى السماء مستحضرين عليها البركة التي هي من فوق. لقد كان الربّ يسوع البداية، النموذج والطريق".

لقد كان واضحاً أن الجموع قد رأت في هذه المعجزة صورة مسيانية للمسيح، إذ قالوا في إنجيل يوحنا " هذا هو بالحقيقة النبي الآتي إلى العالم " (يوحنا 6: 14). لقد تذكر الشعب العبراني آباؤهم الذين أكلوا المنّ في البرية (خروج 16: 4- 16) ورأوا في المسيح صورة المسيّا الذي يُطعم شعبه. هذه الحركات الأفخارستية "أخذ – بارك – كسر وأعطى "كررّها الربّ يسوع ذاتها في العشاء الأخير قبل صلبه وآلامه. يقول الإنجيلي متّى: "وفيما هم يأكلون أخذ يسوع الخبز وبارك وكسر وأعطى التلاميذ وقال خذوا كلوا هذا هو جسدي، وأخذ الكأس وشكر وأعطاهم قائلاً اشربوا منها كلكم " (متى 26: 26).


