

Gospel of the Feast, Matthew 2: 1-12, (Visit of the Magi)

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, Magi came from the East to Jerusalem saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." But when King Herod heard this, he was troubled, and so was all Jerusalem with him. And gathering together all the chief priests and Scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. And they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea; for thus it is written by the prophet, 'And you, Bethlehem, of the land of Judah are by no means least among the princes of Judah; for from you shall come forth a leader who shall shepherd my people, Israel." Then Herod summoned the Magi secretly, and carefully ascertained from them the time when the star had appeared to them. And sending them to Bethlehem he said, "Go and make careful inquiry concerning the Child, and when you have found Him, bring me word, that I too may go and worship Him." Now they, having heard the king, went their way. And behold, the star they had seen in the East went before them, until it came and stood over the place where the Child was. And when they saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly. And entering the house, they found the Child with Mary His mother, and falling down they worshipped Him. And opening their treasures, they offered Him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. And being warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they went back to their own country by another way.

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

Christ is Born! Glorify Him!



The glorious feast of Christmas is finally here, and what a mysterious blessing it is. For the Eternal Word of God becomes a human being—as helpless a babe as was ever born—with a manger for His crib. Angels sing in His honor. The lowly shepherds and the foreign wise men worship Him. A young virgin becomes a mother, not simply of a Son, but of the Son of God. And kings tremble, for this baby brings to earth a Kingdom not of this world.

The good news of Christmas is that Jesus Christ is born this day, not to judge or to destroy us, but to save and bless us. He is the Second Adam in Whom the diseased decay of the first Adam is healed. By becoming one of us, He brings us into the life of God. We are made holy, we are fulfilled, we are raised to life eternal in Him.

Our Lord brings His great joy to the world humbly and peaceably. He does not arrive in the earthly splendor of a king, with the military power of a conquering general, or in the material comfort of the rich. Instead, He takes the lowest, most vulnerable place for Himself: born in a cave used as a barn to a family that lived under the oppression of the Roman Empire and the cruelty of Herod. Soon Joseph would take the Virgin Mary and the young Jesus to Egypt by night, fleeing for their lives from a wicked, murderous king. What a difficult, lowly way to come into a dark and dangerous world, not unlike how refugee children are born in parts of the Middle East, Africa, and other war-torn regions to this very day.

But when we pause to consider the glory of our Lord's Incarnation, we should not be surprised at all. For what does it mean for the Immortal One to put on mortality? What does it mean for the One Who spoke the world into existence to become part of that creation? What does it mean for the King of the universe to become subject to the kings of the world? It means humility and selfless, suffering love beyond our understanding. For our Lord, God, and Savior is not a rational concept to be defined, but a Person Who shares His life with us. So that we could enter into His life, He

entered into ours, sanctifying every bit of what it means to be a human being, literally from the womb to the tomb that could not contain Him.

The wise men show us how to respond to the unbelievably good news that God has become a human being: they worship Him. Let us follow their example this Christmas season by worshipping Him as we open ourselves to the glorious transformation that the Incarnate Son of God brings. For Christ is born, and the peace and joy of God's kingdom are ours even as we live and breathe in the world as we know it. Christ is born, and we encounter Him in every human being, especially the poor, needy, and outcast. Christ is born, and we participate in the eternal life for which we were created in God's image and likeness.

Yes, this wonderful news really is true. And the only limits on the blessing of Christmas are those that we place on ourselves. For the One Who comes as a humble, meek, peaceable baby in a manger never forces us or anyone else. He is the Mystery of Love made flesh for our salvation. If we accept Him, we must become participants in the deified humanity that the God-Man Jesus Christ has brought to the world. We must live in this world in ways that reflect the deep truth of the Incarnation. We must become living icons of the good news of this season.

So this Christmas, let us be like Mary the Theotokos who received Him with joy, like the elder Joseph His steadfast protector, and like that strange combination of lowly shepherds and Persian astrologers who first worshipped Him. Let us welcome Him into our life and live accordingly, for now nothing but our own refusal can separate us from His love. That, my brothers and sisters, is the good news of Christmas.

هي مكوّنة من حجر، محفورة في الصخر. والبيت الصامد والقويّ الذي تحدّث عنه المسيح، هو البيت "المبني على الصخر". وقد سمّى المسيح بطرس صخراً: "وأنا أقول لك: أنت صخر وعلى هذا الصخر سأبني كنيستى، وأبواب الجحيم لن تقوى عليها" (متى 18:18). ترمز المغارة إذن إلى قلب الإنسان الثابت في الله أمام كلّ المعقوبات والتجارب. ونتأمّل في نصّ للقدّيس غريغوريوس اللاهوتي، يتكلُّم فيه عن بيت لحم: "كرّموا بيت لحم، هذه القرية المتواضعة، التي رفعت حقارتكم إلى مجد السماء. مجدوا من ولدوا في المغارة، لأنّ المغارة أصبحت باب "عدن" (أي

لم تعد بيت لحم قرية حقيرة في مدن يهوذا، بل أصبحت قلب كسل إنسسان يسولسد فسيسه الله. كسل إنسسان يسولسد فسيسه الله. لم تعد مجهولة في الزمان والمكان، بل أصبحت في كلّ مكان وزمان، وفي حياة كلّ إنسان قِبل الله". نعم لقد أصبحت بيت لحم كبيرة، واتسعت المغارة للكون كلّه، إذ وسعت ربّ الكون، فصارت تشبه قلب كلّ محبّ. واكتملت بذلك النبوءة، إذ أعطت بيت لحم (أي بيت الخبز) المسيح خبزاً حياً لكلّ النبوءة، إذ أعطت بيت لحم (أي بيت الخبز) المسيح خبزاً حياً الحيل منه يحيا إلى الأبد.

تأمل في النجم:

يرمز النجم إلى النور: "أنتم نور العالم" (متى 5:14). والمسيح نورٌ. وقد جاء النور إلى العالم ليضيء الظلمة: "ما دمت في العالم، فأنا نور العالم" (يو5:9)

ويرمز النجم أيضا إلى يسوع الذي يقودنا إلى الآب. والى المسيحيين الذين يقودوننا إلى الله. لذلك نحن أبناء النور وأبناء النهار. ويرمز أيضا إلى المبشرين الذين يبشرون بالنور في عالم الظلمة. ويرمز إلى الكاهن الواقف أمام الهيكل. فهو نجم يضيء الكنيسة كلها، ويوجّهنا نحو الله الموجود في الهيكل. لذلك على المؤمنين أن يتمسكوا بالمسيح "كما بمصباح يضيء في مكان مظلم، إلى أن ينفجر النهار ويشرق كوكب الصبح في قلوبكم" (2 بط1: 19). فالنجم إذن، دعوة لنا لنكون النور على المنارة، وليس تحت المكيال (متى 51-16).

الذهب والبخور والمرّ:

قدّم المجوس للمسيح الذهب دلالة على أنّه ملك، وملكه أبديّ وسلطانه لا يبلي؛ ودلالـة عـلـى أن مـجـد البـشـر لا يـدوم بـدون مـجـد الله. وقدّموا له البخور، دلالةً على أنه إله أزليّ، وأن كلّ من لا يرتبط به لا يثبت. وقدّموا له المرّ دلالة على أنه كإنسان، سيتحمّل آلام الإنسانية، الذي بطل مفهومها كعقاب. وطالما أن هناك إنساناً يتالم فالله لا يزال يتألم. فالمغارة إذن، هي مكان التقاء الإنسان مع الله بالتواضع، المرشد إلى الآب. تجسد الله في عالم الإنسان، وسلطان الله على الأرض.

يرمز الرعاة إلى الله الآب راعي الرعاة (حزقيال 34: 1-16) ويرمز الرعاة أيضاً إلى الفقراء، الناظرين إلى السماء، الذين كانوا ينظرون

إلى الملائكة، ولو أنهم كانوا ينظرون إلى أغنامهم، لما رأوا علامة السماء. وهذا مهم جداً بالنسبة لرعاة الكنيسة ولكل مسيحي ولكل صاحب قرار أن ينظروا إلى السماء والي شريعتها الإلهية، والي المحبّة المتجلية في عمل الله وكل الخلائق ورحمته اللامتناهية لضعفنا وخطايانا، قبل أن يصدروا أحكامهم على من هم مسؤولون عنهم.

يقول الإنجيل عن هؤلاء الرعاة: "طوبى لانقياء القلب، فإنهم يعاينون الله" (متى 8:5). لأنّ محبّتهم للمسيح المولود، تخطّت فقرهم، والكثير من هموم الحياة التي كانت تثقل كاهلهم، وجعلتهم يتبعون كلام الملائكة، ويسهرعون إلى المخدرة مريم ويوسف، والطفل مضجعاً في "ليجدوا مريم ويوسف، والطفل مضجعاً في المذود" (لو 2:16)، فأصبحوا أغنياء بالله الذي المتود" لأجلهم. فبلغوا مع المجوس إلى الذي لا يُبلغ إليه:

أي إلى الله. فهم إذن العيون الشاخصة نحو السماء، والمتأملة في أمورها.

يرمز الرعاة أيضاً إلى المسيح، الراعي الصالح (يو 10: 11)، والى السرسل، النين هم رعاة العالم. وكلّ واحد منّا هو راع الإخوته البشر العائشين معه. فهم إذن، يطرحون علينا السؤال التالي: "إلى أين تُتجّه أنظارك؟ أإلى السماء أم إلى الأرض؟ أإلى الخدمة أم إلى التسلط؟ إلى الذي يدول؟

ونحن بدورنا، إن لم نتخل عن ذواتنا، وننطلق مثل الرعاة، متخلّين عن راحتنا وأنانيتنا الشخصية، لنفتش عن الطفل الجديد، فلن يتم الميلاد في حياتنا، ولن نرى شيئاً من عجائبه

يرمز القديس يوسف إلى الطاعة الواعية والصامتة. ويرمز إلى تتميم إرادة الله بصمت. فهو لم يتمرّد لم يتنمّر. واستطاع أن يحمي الله المتجسد بيسوع المسيح، بصمته المصلي. وتصرّف كما أمره الملاك بدون جدال. وهو يرمز إلى الإنسان المترقّب لعلامات الله في حياته، دون أن يرفضها أو يتهرّب منها، حتى لو يفهمها.

كذلك حين شك يوسف في قلبه وخاف، لم يتردد أن يأخذ مريم، كما أمره المملاك، مخضعاً منطقه لنعمة الله وعمله. فهل من إيمان أكبر؟ إنّه بنى بيته على صخر الإيمان، فلم تحطمه سيول الشك " فكل من سمع أقوالي هذه وعمل بها يُشبه رجلاً عاقلاً بنى بيته على الصخر: فهطل المطر، وجاءت السيول، وعصفت الرياح، وانقضت على ذلك البيت فلم يسقط لأنّ أساسه ثابتٌ على الصخر" (متى 7: 24-25)

ربّي يسوع، في زمن الحبّ والعطاء، زمن التجسد، حيث يصبح الله إنسانا ليصبح الإنسان إلهاً. تُرسل السماء خالقها، وتستقبل الأرض من يقدّسها؛ ويتأله الإنسان، لأن الله يصبح ابن الإنسان، وتربّل الملائكة بالمجد، ويبلغ المجوس ملء الحقيقة بلقائهم طفل المذود، ويجد الرعاة الراعي الصالح. "وتلد العذراء الكلمة الكانن قبل الدهور، ولادة تفوق كلّ وصف، وتحدّم الأرض السمغسارة لسمن لا يسدنسي مسنه فافرحي أيتها المسكونة، ومجّدي من شاء أن يظهر طفلاً جديداً، إلهنا الذي قبل الدهور". شكراً يا يسوع، لأنك أصبحت صغيراً، لكي نصبح نحن الصغار، قريبين إلى الله بك، وجعلت روحك يصلّي فينا: "لك المجد يا متجسداً في حبّك. آمين.



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

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
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
