# Epistle of St. Basil (Colossians 2: 8-12) Prokimenon

My mouth shall speak wisdom; prudence shall be the utterance of my heart.

Stichon: Hear this, all you peoples; hearken, all who dwell in the world.

#### Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Colossians

Brethren, see to it that no one deceives you by philosophy and vain deceit, according to human traditions, according to the elements of the world, and not according to Christ. For in him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and in him who is the head of every Principality and Power you have received of that fullness. In him, too, you have been circumcised with a circumcision not wrought by hand, but through putting off the body of the flesh, a circumcision which is of Christ. For you were buried with him in baptism, and in him also rose again through faith in the working of God who rose him from the dead.

Listen, O Shepherd of Israel, O Guide of Joseph's flock! Stichon: The mouth of the just tells of wisdom, and his tongue says what is right.

# Gospel of Circumcision (Luke 2:20-21 & 40-52)

At that time the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, even as it was spoken to them. And when eight days were fulfilled for the circumcision of the child, he was called Jesus, the name given him by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. And the child grew and became strong in spirit. He was full of wisdom and the grace of God was upon him. And his parents were accustomed to go every year to Jerusalem at the Feast of the Passover. And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem according to the custom of the feast. And after they had fulfilled the days, when they were returning the boy Jesus remained in Jerusalem, and Joseph and his mother did not know it. But thinking he was in the caravan; they had come a day's journey before it occurred to them to look for him among their relatives and acquaintances. And not finding him, they returned to Jerusalem in search of him. And it came to pass after three days, that they found him in the temple sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. And all who were listening to him were amazed at understanding and his answers. And when they saw him, they were astonished. And his mother said to him, "Son, why have you done so to us? Behold, your father and I have been seeking you sorrowing." And he said to them, "How is it that you sought me? Did you now know I must be about my Father's business?" And they did not understand the word he spoke to them. And he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them; and his mother kept all these things carefully in her heart. And Jesus advanced in wisdom and age and grace before God and men.


### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK





BASIL OF CAESAREA, USIJALLY
CALLED BASIL THE GREAT, WAS
ONE OF ELEVEN CHILDREN BORN
IN A WEALTHY CHRISTIAN FAMILY
IN CAPPADOGIA (ASIA MINOR).
AND WHAT A FAMILY: THREE OF HIS
SIBLINGS ARE CONSIDERED SAINTS,
AND HIS MOTHER'S PARENTS ENDURED
FIERCE ANTI-CHRISTIAN PERSECUTION,
FLEEING FOR THEIR LIVES. HIS MOM
AND SISTER (BOTH NAMED MACRINA)
TUTORED HIM IN THE FAITH AND PREPARED HIM FOR THE BEST SCHOOLS.

BASIL WAS THE OLDEST AND MOST PROMINENT OF THE THREE BISHOPS KNOWN AS THE CAPPADOCIAN FATHERS. THE OTHER TWO WERE BOTH NAMED GREGORY: GREGORY OF NYSSA WAS BASIL'S YOUNGER BROTHER, AND GREGORY OF NAZIANZUS WAS HIS BEST FRIEND FROM COLLEGE. AT BASIL'S INITIATIVE THESE THREE MEN FOUNDED A NEW CHRISTIANIZED CULTURE IN THE GREEK WORLD AND MADE PERMANENT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CHURCH'S THEOLOGY, LITURGY AND MONASTIC LIFE. THEIR INFLUENCE WAS VAST!



ONE OF BASIL'S MOST IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CHURCH'S DOCTRINE WAS IN HIS TEACHING ON THE TRINITY. MORE THAN ANYONE BEFORE HIM BASIL HAD A VERY CLEAR UNDERSTANDING THAT IT IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT TO DISCERN THE THREE PERSONS IN GOD AS IT IS TO RECALL THAT GOD IS ONLY ONE IN ESSENCE. HE ESTABLISHED THE FORMULA "GOD IS THREE PERSONS IN ONE NATURE."





**BASIL PREACHED A SERIES** OF SERMONS ON THE SIX DAYS OF CREATION, THE HEXAEMERON. IN THESE **IMPORTANT MESSAGES** HE ESTABLISHED THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE OLD PAGAN IDEAS ABOUT THE WORLD, AND THE NEW, AUTHENTICALLY CHRISTIAN UNDERSTANDING OF IT. CHRISTIANS BELIEVE THAT GOD CREATED THE WORLD AS A GOOD, ORDERLY, FINITE REALITY. THE WORLD IS NOT A NATURAL EXTENSION OF GOD'S OWN BEING, NOR IS IT MADE OF EVIL MATERIAL.

Forgive us for the times we have worked so hard to be self-sufficient, forgetting our need for you, living independent of your spirit. Forgive us for letting fear and worry control our minds, and for allowing pride and selfishness wreak havoc over our lives. Forgive us for not following your ways and for living distant from your presence. We confess our need for you... fresh...new...again. We ask that you make all things new, in our hearts, in our minds, in our lives, for this coming year. We pray for your refreshing over us.

Keep your words of truth planted firm within us, help us to keep focused on what is pure and right, give us the power to be obedient to your word. And when the enemy reminds us where we have been, hissing his lies and attacks our way, we trust that your voice speaks louder and stronger, as you remind us we are safe with you and your purposes and plans will not fail.
