

The Byzantine Church attaches a great importance to the Theophany because of its deep theological significance. What is celebrated is not so much the historical fact of the manifestation of the Holy Trinity to the world for the very first time, nor the beginning of Christ's public life, nor again the Baptism administered by John: it is rather the manifestation of God's glory, of his love for mankind, of His mercy and compassion expressed in the Person of Jesus Christ, who assumed flesh and became Man in order to become a sacrifice of salvation for the sake of all men. "The grace of God our Savior has appeared to all men" (Titus 2:11).

Inspired by the baptism of Christ and by this stirring of divine life poured forth for the salvation and sanctification of mankind, the early Church reserved this day for the baptism of the catechumens, unceasingly repeating with St, Paul: "All of you who have been baptized into Christ, have put on Christ." Alleluia!

Baptism

Today we celebrate the baptism of Our Lord. After Jesus had prayed and fasted in the desert for forty days He went to where Saint John the Baptist was baptizing people in the Jordan river. People were coming to Saint John, confessing their sins, and he was baptizing them with water. Saint John told the people that he only baptized with water, but One would come after him Who would baptize them with the Holy Spirit. He was talking about Jesus.


When Jesus came to him, Saint John did not want to baptize Him- he said that Jesus should baptize him instead! But Jesus wanted Saint John to baptize Him so that He could be an example for all of us.

The baptism that Saint John was giving was only a sign of people being sorry for their sins. The baptism that Jesus gave us really takes away our sins. It makes us members of Jesus' Church and takes away both original sin and any actual sins we have done. We still have the effects of original sin, which are pain and death and a tendency to sin, but our souls are made perfectly clean when we are baptized. If we sin after

our baptism we can be forgiven in the sacrament of confession.


Today ask your parents about your baptism, and thank God for letting you become part of His family, the Church.

The Fruit of repentance (St. Gregory)



"Repentance is the beginning, middle and end of the Christian way of life (St. Gregory Palamas)."

It is the beginning of a blessed New Year! There seems to be joy in the hearts of many as the need to embrace a positive new beginning of things is once again given to us. The Church too, sends out a strong and powerful message with the Feast of Theophany, on January 6, which is echoed loudly in the words of St. Gregory – repentance is the beginning, middle and end of the Christian Way of life. The word for repentance in Greek is metania which means to have a change in one's thoughts, thinking and way of living in the world. Let us enter once again into the waters of baptism and the great gift of Christ it brings into our lives.

When St. John the Baptist explained the meaning of repentance he was specific and gave instructions according to the occupation of each person. St. Gregory points out that following confession *fruit* would appear in the lives of those repenting.

The Fruit of repentance (St. Gregory)

- Righteousness doing and being right before God. To have Christ dwelling in us so that we treat everyone as if Christ is dwelling in them. To live righteously is to work truthfully with all clients. This requires ceasing to lie and deceive others just to take advantage of them or a situation.
- Almsgiving sharing from the abundant blessings given to us by God. Having made enough money to live on and take care of our basic needs – with an abundance we can now take care of the needs of others with joyful hearts and thankfulness of everything received. Withholding from others deprives us of the joy of being able to give unto others as we have been given.
- Moderation being content with what God has blessed us with.

To live not beyond one's means but within the boundaries of God's blessings is accomplished by not desiring what others have. Envy is the absence of moderation.

- Love caring for others who have no one to care for them. What does it mean to love in the workplace? It means to seek the benefit of someone else over oneself. It means to give someone our entire attention and listen to their needs and not my need to make a sale. It means to treat each person without labeling them with any other label than *child of God*.
 - Truthfulness integrity and honesty dictate our behavior in our professions. When we are true with God; we can begin to be true to ourselves and others. Integrity is being able to speak the truth in love. It means being able to be who we truly are in the presence of others. It means being able to pursue truth above all else even when it means knowing that someone else may be able to help someone better than we can and having the honesty to be able to tell them so. "As I speak these words to you, brethren, I feel no small pain in my soul, that we who were long ago granted Christian baptism have not yet accomplished those very things which John demanded of those approaching his own baptism...Christ who takes away the sin of the world enters the water before us to be baptized...He draws the grace of the allholy Spirit from above to dwell in the water with Him, so that later when those being baptized as He was enter the water, He is there, clothing them ineffably with His Spirit, attaching Himself to them, and filling them with the grace that purifies and illumines reasonable spirits (Gregory Palamas)."

طالما انتظر اليهود يوم الرّبّ هذا: انتظروا وصوك المسيح المخلّص، يأتي ليرفع الظُلم عن شعبه. لقد انتظروا مسيحًا قويًّا، مُقاتلاً، قائدًا جيش إسرائيل. إنتظروا مسيحًا معاقبًا يحرق الخطأة بنار غضبه. انتظروه ملكًا يخلق بالقوّة ملوك الطغيان ليعيد إحياء عرش داود أبيه، ملك إسرائيل، ويوحِّد بقوّة ذراعه قبائل إسرائيل المشتّتة.

لم ينتظروه مسيحًا ضعيفًا، لم ينتظروه مسيحًا ينحني أمام يوحنّا، لم يقبلوه مسيحًا يعلن ملكه لا بالسيف بل بالماء، ويغلب الشرّ لا بالحرب بل بمعموديّة التوبة.

هو منطق مسيح بيت لحم، المولود كالفقراء، لم يجدٍ له مكانًا فحلّ في إسطبل. هو منطق مسيح البشارة، لم يجد له موضعًا يلقي عليه رأسه، هو منطق مسيح الناصرة، ظنَّ أقاربه أنّه قد فقد العقل، هو منطق مسيح أورشليم، يحني الرأس أمام رعاع يضربونه بقصبة، يهزأون به، يقولون له متهكّمين: "تنبّأ من ضربك".

هو منطق الانسان المسالم، يرفض قبول منطق العنف، لأنّ "من ياخذ بالسّيف، فبألسّيف يؤخذ"، و**لأنّ العالم لا يمكن للعنف أن يشفيه،** وحده السّلام، وحده الحبّ، وحدها المُصالحة، يمكنها أن تشفي جراح قلبنا العنيف فتعطيه السَّلام.

المسيح الداخل مياه الأردنّ هو نفسه المسيح الذي يدخل عالمنا، يدخل واقعنا ويتبنّى حقيقتنا ليغيّرها من الدّاخل، يغيّرها بصمت، يلقي في حقيقتنا حقيقته، فتنمو فينا بصمت كما تنمو السنبلة، دون ضجيج، دون هتاف الانتصار، ودون قسوة السّيف وعنف الحرب. حقيقة المسيح تنمو في حياتنا وفي عالمنا بهدوء، وبسلامها تبدّل واقعنا.

لقد دخل المسيح مياه الأردن، هو غير المحتاج إلى التوبة، لأنَّه لمِ يقترف معصيّة، هو البرارة المتجسّدة، جاء يعلّمنا، يقول لنا أنّ **الدّخول في علاقة مع الآب لا يمكنها أن تتمّ إن لم نختبر معنى التوبة، معنى العودة إلى الآب**. بخطيئتنا فقدنا صداقتنا مع الله، وحدها التوبة تعيدنا إلى حالة البنّوة.

المسيح في نهر الأردنّ هو صورة كلّ واحد منّا، إنسانيّته التي دخلت مياه معموديّة يوحنّا هي صورة إنسانيّتنا المدعوّة إلى التوبة وإلى العودة إلى الله.

يعلن الخلاص، بنا يصالح العالم مع الله، بنا يشغي القلوب الجريحة، بنا يعيد بناء حياة تحطّمت. بمعموديّتنا نعلن أنّنا صرنا ملك الله ووسيلة قداسة العالم، نضع ذواتنا بتصرّف المسيح ليعمل من خلالنا، نصبح، كما قال بولس "سغراء المسيح لدى الأمم كلّها". نحن الفقراء، لا نملك شيئًا، نصبح أغنى الأغنياء، لأنّنا نحمل المسيح في حياتنا، وفي جسدنا، وفي قلوبنا، ننطلق به نحو إخوتنا، ليختبروا هم أيضًا عِظْمَ المسيح وغنى محبّته.

هي دعوة الى القداسة

معموديّة المسيح هي صورة عن حقيقة كلّ واحد منّا، نُصغي لدعوة الله في قلبنا، نعود إلى صوت الضمير، نقبل الله في حياتنا، نتكرّس له بالمعموديّة، نصبح له بكلّيتنا، نضع ذاتنا بين يديه، نقول له: أريد أن أكون وسيلة لك، لتقدّس الإخوة من خلالي. حلول الرّوح على المسيح في الأردن هو صورة عن حلول الله على حياتي. كما كان روح الرّب يرفرف على الغمار في البدء، قبل أن يخلق الله السّماوات، وكانت الأرض خَرِبَةً خالية، فحوّلها الله بروحه إلى تحفة تمجّد الخالق بجمالها، كذلك يحلّ على أنا ساعة المعموديّة، يحلّ على خراب الخالق بجمالها الذي سبّبته خطيئتي، يحلّ على قلبي الفارغ كفراغ الوجود قبل الخلق، يحلّ عليّ فيجعلني أنا أيضًا تحفة رائعة الجمال، أعلن للكون عن جمال الله من خلال جمال النِعمة التي نلتها، نعمة أن أكون ابنًا لله.

هي دعوة الى التوبة

الله لا يختار كمالي، فهو أحبّني رغم ضعفي، ورغم خطيئتي، أحبّني كما يحبّ الأب ابنه المريض الضعيف، يحبّني رغم سقطاتي ورغم هفواتي، يريدني أن أكون له، ليعمل في حياتي، ويبدّل ضعفي بقوّته، ويبدّل خطيئتي بنعمته. **دعوة الله هي ليست لأنّي كامل، بل لأنّي ابن لله، وكمالي يتحقّق بطاعتي الكاملة لإرادته التي تقدّسني. اتباعي لله لا ينتهي بعد المعموديّة، بل هي دعوة مستمرّة لتوبة يوميّة. في كلّ لحظة من حياتي أنا مدعو لأنّ أعود إلى الله، ولأن أعلن له كلّ لحظة أنّي إحبّه، فهو دعاني لأنّه اختارني، وهو اختارني لأنّه أحبّني، وهو أحبّني لأنّه أبي، ولأنّه جعل منّي ابنًا له بالمعموديّة.**

بالمعموديّة تتحقَّق في حياتنا الشخصيّة إمكانيّة الإتّحاد بالحبّ الإلـهـيّ، فبالمعموديّة نصبح أبناء الله، نسمع صوته يقول لنا: أنتَ ابني الـحـبـيـب. يفرح قلب الآب بنا، ويُسرّ بأن قد وُلد له بالنِعمـة وبـالـرّوح الـقـدس إبـن جديد. هذا هو سرّ المعموديّة، هذا سبب دخول المسيح اليوم في ميـاه الأردنّ.

فهل نعي في حياتنا هذه الحقيقة؟ هل ندرك عظمة حبّ الله لنا؟ هل نفهم كم أنّنا نجرح قلب الله الذي أحبّنا بإصرارنا على البقاء في خطيئتنا؟ هي دعوة لنا لأن نتوب، لأن نعود الى الآب، لأنّ المسيح قد فتح لنا باب العودة إلى حالة البنوّة. هي دعوة لنا لأن نحافظ على شرف معموديّتنا، فلا نرمي جواهر الرّوح القدس في أوحال خطيئتنا. هي دعوة لنا لأن نعود إلى الآب في حال سقطنا، وتعبنا، ويئسنا، فالله يحبّنا وينتظرنا، ينتظرنا ليغفر لنا، ليضمّنا إلى قلبه، ويهمس في أذننا من جديد: أنت هو إبني الحبيب، بك أنا سُررت.
