Jesus Ascends into Heaven!



After his resurrection Jesus ascended to heaven.



Feast of the Ascension of our Lord

Each Sunday we profess through the Creed, "He ascended into Heaven." Christ's Ascension was the culmination of God's Divine plan for Christ Jesus - his return to his Father with his "Mission Accomplished."

Ascension is the grand finale of all Jesus' words and works done for us and for our salvation. It is a culmination, but not the conclusion. As Jesus is now with God in glory, so





- 1) We need to be proclaimers and evangelizers: In today's Gospel, Jesus gives this mission to all the believers: "Go out to the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature." This mission is not given to a select few but to all believers. To be a Christian is to be a proclaimer and an evangelizer. There is a difference between preaching and proclaiming. "We preach with words but we proclaim with our lives." As we celebrate the Lord's return to His Father in Heaven - His Ascension -- we are being commissioned to go forth and proclaim the Gospel of life and love, of hope and peace, by the witness of our lives. On this day of hope, encouragement and commissioning, let us renew our commitment to be true disciples everywhere we go, beginning with our family and our parish, "living in a manner worthy of the call [we] have received."
- 2) We need to live a life of Christian joy in the presence of the ascended Lord. According to Luke, the disciples "returned to Jerusalem with great joy." Apparently Jesus' exaltation and final blessing gave them, as it gives us, the assurance that, though become other Christs in the world



absent, Jesus is still present, present even in the pain and sorrow we undergo. That is why St. Augustine assures "Christ is us. exalted above the Heavens, but he still suffers on earth all the pain that we, members of his Body. have to bear. showed this when he cried out from above: 'Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?' and when he said: 'I was hungry and you gave me food.' While in Heaven he is also with us; and while on earth we are with him. He is

Jesus is with us now in Spirit: "Lo, I am with you always." The feast here with us by his Divinity, his power and his love. We cannot be in of the Ascension celebrates one aspect of the Resurrection, namely Heaven, as he is on earth, by divinity, but in him, we can be there

- 3) We have a teaching mission: Jesus taught us lessons of Faith, Hope, forgiveness, mercy, redemption and Love. We cannot put these lessons on a shelf and ignore them. They stand before us in the person of Jesus. Although no longer visibly present in the world, Jesus is present in his words., and we must make these words real in our lives as well as in the lives of others. Christianity was meant to be a Faith in which Jesus' followers would help and care for others, just as Jesus had done. But the spreading of the Good News to all nations is not a goal that can be attained by human might and craft. This is why Jesus promises to empower the Church with His abiding presence and that of the Holy Spirit. The challenge of sharing the Good News with all mankind should, therefore, begin with our admission that we have often been arrogant and overbearing. We must learn to be humble and let the Holy Spirit lead the way.
- 4) The ascended Jesus is our source of strength and encouragement: Perhaps some of the nagging doubts which inevitably accompany the journey of Faith could be lessened by our meditating on the Ascension and its implications. When we are too far from Faith to pray on our own, let us remember that we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the Righteous, praying for us. When the trials of life feel too heavy to bear, we must remember that Christ will come again in glory, the same glory in which Jesus arose from the tomb, the same glory to which Jesus ascended, and the same glory in which Jesus currently abides. Though our limited perception might find him absent, Jesus is fully present, participating in every moment of our lives. By His Ascension, Christ has not deserted us but has made it possible for the Holy Spirit to enter all times and places. In this way it is possible for each of us to be transformed by the power of the Spirit into agents or instruments of Christ. We become enlivened, and our actions become animated in a new way by the Spirit of the God we love and serve. We have

ما معنى عيد الصعود وكيف نعيشه؟

في خميس الصُّعُود نُعيّدُ لصعود ربّنا وإلهنا ومخلصنا يسوع المسيح إلى السمّاء، وذلك بعد أربعين يومًا من قيامَتِه وظهوره للتّلاميذ. "فيسوعُ هذا الَّذي رُفِعَ عَنكُم إلى السَّماء سَيأتي كما رَ أَيثُموه ذاهبًا إلى السَّماء" (اعمال 1:11). صعد يسوع الى السماء وعاد الى ملكوته (يوحنا 18: 36) بعد أن أتمَّ عمل الفداء وأكمل خطة الخلاص. فالصُّعُود خاتمة عيد قيامة المسيح وحياته على الأرض. وهذا ما نعبر عنه في قانون الإيمان: لقد صللب عنًا على عهد بيلاطس البنطى، تألَّم ومات وقبر وقام في اليوم الثَّالث، كما في الكتب، وصعد إلى السماء وجلس عن يمين الآب، وأيضا سيأتي بمجد عظيم. ومن هنا نسأل ما هي ابعاد عيد الصُّعُود وكيف نعيشه؟ يمكننا أن نميّز ثلاثة أبعاد للصعود على صعيد المسيح والكنيسة وصعيدنا.



(الصُعُود تمجيد المسيح السماوي إن المسيح قبل أن يعيش على الأرض يمكن القول إنه كان لدى الله كابن، و"كلمة"، وحكمة. فصعوده إلى السماء إلى يعيش الأب إنما هو عودة إلى العالم السماوي الذي منه سبق ونزل من السماء، مسكن الألوهية (رؤيا 1: 5) رحمةً بنا ليفتقد الناس (مزمور 144:5). بالصُعُود والنزول ارتبطت السماء بالأرض (يوحنا 1: 51). واما جلوس يسوع عن يمين الله فيعني أنه قد أكمل عمله وأن له سلطاناً وقد توّج ملكاً. والتالي ما صعوده الا تعبير عن محد المسيح السماوي (أعمال 2: 34).

ومن ناحية أخرى يشير صعود المسيح الى الدخول النهائي لناسوت يسوع الى مقر الله السماوي من حيث سيعود، ويخفيه هذا المقر في هذا الوقت عن عيون البشر. (ت ك 665). وفي الليتورجيا السريانية نجد هذه الصلاة التي تعبّر عن تمجيد المسيح بصعود الى السماء: "نزل ربّنا بحثًا عن آدم وبعد أن وجد من كان ضائعًا، حمله على كنفيه وبالمجد أدخله السماوات معه (لوقا 15: 4). أتى وأظهر لنا أنه الله؛ ولبس جسدًا وكشف لنا أنه إنسان. نزل إلى الجحيم وبيّن لنا أنه مات؛ صعد وتمجّد وأظهر لنا أنّه كبير. فليتبارك مجده!".

(2 لصَّغود دلالة على تسامي المسيح يدل صعود يسوع الى السماء على تساميه على الكون والقوات السماوية كما جاء في تعليم بولس السول" ثُمَّ يَكُونُ المُنتَهى حِينَ يُسْلِّمُ المُلْكَ إلى الله الآب بَعدَ أَن يَكُونَ قد أَبادَ كُلَّ رئاسة وسُلطانِ وقُوَّة "(1 قورنتس 15: 24). وكما قال النبي: "أيّها الرَّبُ سَيّدُنا ما أعظمَ اسمَكَ في الأرضِ كُلِّها! لأَعظِمَنَ جَلاَلكَ فَوقَ السَّمَوات" (مزمور 8: 2).

ويسوع منذ الأن يجلس على العرش في السماوات ليتقلد السيادة على الكون (أفسس 1: 20-21). ويكشف لنا انجيل متى سلطان يسوع الذي يتمتع به في السماء وعلى الأرض (متى 28: 18)، وأكد لنا بولس الرسول هذا النصر الذي اكتسبه بالصلب (كولسي 2: 15) وبطاعته (فيلبي 2: 6-11). ويقول القديس كبريانوس: "لا من لسان بشر ولا ملائكي يستطيع أن يصف كما يجب عظيم الاحتفال والاكرام الذي صار للإله المتجسد بصعوده في هذا اليوم".

(3 الصَّغُود تمهيد لعودة المسيح في مجينه الثاني إن "يسوغ هذا الَّذي رُفِعَ عَنكُم إلى السَّماء سَياتي كما رَأَيتُموه ذاهبًا إلى السَّماء" (أعمال 1: 11). هذه العبارة تقيم ارتباطاً عميقاً بين ارتفاع المسيح إلى السماء وبين عودته ثانية في آخر الأزمنة، عند التجديد الكلي الشامل (أعمال 3: 21) حينذاك سيأتي كما انطلق (أعمال 1:11)، ناز لا من السماء (1 تسالونيقي 4: 16) على الغمام (رؤيا 14: 14-16)، بينما يصعد مختاروه لملاقاته، هم أيضا على غمام (1 تسالونيقي 4: 17). فالتاريخ يتحرك نحو نقطة محددة هي مجيء يسوع المسيح ثانية ليدين العالم، ويملك على كل المسكونة. وينبغي علينا، أن نكون مستعدين لمجيئه المفاجئ (1 تسالونيقي 5: 2).

ثانيًا: الصُّغُود على صعيد الكنيسة:

الصُّغُود على مستوى الكنيسة هو تمجيدها بحلول الروح القدس: تمجيد المسيح في صعوده كان لا بد أن يسبق تمجيد الكنيسة بحلول الروح القدس ليحلّ بد أن يسبق تمجيد الكنيسة بحلول الروح القدس ليحلّ محلّه لدى التلاميذ كما وعد تلاميذه "الرُّوحَ القُدُسَ يَنزلُ عَليكم فَتَنَالُونَ قُدرَةً وتكونونَ لي شُهودًا في أُورَ شَليم وَكُلِّ اليهودِيَّةِ والسَّامِرَة، حتَّى أقاصى الأرض (اعمال 1: 8).

صعد يسوع إلى السماء كي يرسل روحه ليحلّ محلّه لدى التلاميذ. وبحلول الروح يتحوَّل الرب من كانن معنا إلى كانن فينا؛ ان كانن معنا محدودة، لكن كانن فينا غير محدودة وذلك نتيجة عمل الروح القدس. وهذا مما يؤكده القديس بولس الرسول في صلاته الى اهل أفسس: "أن يُقيمَ المسيحُ في

قُلوبِكم بالإيمان" بفعل الروح القدس (أفسس 3: 17).

(1صعود يسوع ليشفع فينا في حضرة الله (عبرانيين 9: 24) تصور الرسالة إلى العبرانيين صعود المسيح في ضوء نظرتها لعالم سماوي تقوم فيه حقائق الخلاص، ونحوه تتجه مسيرة البشر. إن الكاهن الأعظم، لكي يجلس هناك عن يمين الله (عبرانيين 1: 3) فوق الملائكة (عبرانيين 1: 4-9) صعد أول الجميع، مجتازاً السماوات (عبرانيين 4: 14) يشفع فينا في حضرة الله (عبرانيين9: 24) على انه الوسيط الذي يضمن لنا فيض الروح القدوس (ت ك

667)، ويُعلق القديس أو غسطينوس" صعد يسوع الى السماء، لذلك علينا ألا نقلق على الأرض. لتكن أفكارنا هناك وسوف يكون هناك سلام. إن أردنا ان نصعد ونكون بصحبته فيجب علينا أن نكف عن الخطية وعن الشر".

(2 الصُّعُود لإعداد مكان لنا في السماء

يعودُ الربّ بالمجد إلى أبيه ليُعدَ لنا مكانًا (يوحنا 14: 1-3). فقد دخل يسوع أولاً تلك الحياة، ليُعدَّ لمختاريه مكاناً، ثم يأتي وياخذهم إلى هناك ليكونوا على الدوام معه (يوحنا 14: 22). فيسوع المسيح، رأس الكنيسة، سبقنا إلى ملكوت الآب المجيد حتى نحيا نحن، أعضاء جسده، في رجاء أن نكون يوماً معه إلى الأبد (ت ك 666). إذًا فنحن لدينا ضمانة في السماء حيث سنصعد مع الرّب يسوع المسيح. وقد وعد يسوع جميع المؤمنين العاملين بوصاياه خاصة وصية المحبة بالوطن السماوي "تَعالُوا، يا من باركهم أبي، فرثوا الملكوت المُعدَّد لَكُم مَنذُ إنشاء العالم" (متى 25: مهذا الامر يدعونا ان نترنَم مع صلاة قداس الصّعُود: "ليغمُّ السرورُ قلوبنا، لأنّ صعود ابنك إلى السماء، هو عنوان رفعتنا، إذ مسكنه الأن سيكون مسكننا الحقيقي الأخير"؛ ويُعلق القديس أوغسطينوس:" إلهي، إنك صنعتنا لأجلك. لذلك يبقي قلبنا مضطربًا قلقًا عديم الراحة على الدوام حتى يستريح بك".

رابعًا: كيف نعيش روحانية عيد الصُّعُود؟

من ابعاد عيد الصنّعُود تنبع روحانية الصنّعُود متكاملة، مؤسسة على الرجاء، لأنها تجعل المسيحي يحيا منذ الآن في حقيقة العالم الجديد الذي يملك المسيح فيه. إن على المسيحيين وهم في انتظار تلك الساعة، أن يظلو امتحدين بفضل الإيمان وأسرار الكنيسة، بسيدهم المُمجّد. فعليهم ان يسعوا "إلى الأمور الّتي في العلمي كيث المسيخ قد جَلس عن يَمينِ الله"، لأن "حَياتُهم مُحتَجِبةٌ مَعَ المسيح" (قولسي 3: 1-2)، ومدينتهم كائنة في السماوات (فيلبي 3: 21)، "الإنسان السماوي ينتظرهم (2 قورنتس 5: 31) هو المسيح المُمجّد نفسه (فيلبي 3: 21)، "الإنسان السماوي" (1 قورنتس 5: 31-49). على أن المسيحي ليس لذلك أن يكون منسلخاً عن العالم، بل له رسالة على أن يحيا فيه بطريقة جديدة، تحرك العالم نحو المجد الذي يدعوه الله إليه. وهذ الأمر يذكرنا بقصيدة "إرادة الحياة" للشاعر أبو القاسم الشابي "من يتهيّب صعود الجبال يَعش أبَدَ الدَّهر بين الحداث " أو الخوف والرعب والأوبئة والمعاناة على الارض ليس لها الكلمة الاخيرة. سيعود يسوع بالمجد والبهاء ويُضفي سيطرة على ممالك هذا العالم.

الصَّعُود عيد يسوع نعترف به مسيحاً، نعترف به رباً ارتفع ليجتذب الجميع ويصل كامته الى العالم كله. ومن هنا علينا ان نتابع كرازة الانجيل كما اوصانا الرب "إنِّي أُوليثُ كُلُّ سُلطانٍ في السَّماءِ والأرض، فاذهبوا وتلمِذوا جَميعَ الأُمْم، وعَمِّدوهم باسْمِ الآب والابْن والرُّوحَ القُدُس، وعَلِّموهم أن يَحفَظوا كُلُّ ما أَوصَيتُكُم به، وهاءنذا معكم طُوال الأيَّامِ إلى نِهايةِ العالم" (متى 28: 18-20). التلاميذ لم يعيشوا كل الأيام في حين الكنيسة تدوم إلى الأبد (أعمال 1: 4-9).

وعلينا ان نعلن انتظارنا لمجيئه الثاني. إنه سيأتي كما صعد، لذلك انتظار مجيء المسيح عقيدة "ونتظر قيامة الأموات وحياة الدهر الآتي آمين" ومع الليتورجيا السريانيّة نردد "يوم ولادته، فرحت مريم؛ يوم مماته، تزلزلت الأرض. يوم قيامته، تزعزعت ظلمات الجحيم؛ يوم صعوده، اغتبطت السماوات. فليتبارك صعوده"، والقديس أبيغانيوس يقول: أن هذا اليوم هو مجد بقية الأعياد وشرفها لأنه يتضح أن الرب أكمل في هذا العيد عمل الراعي العظيم (لوقا 15: 4-7).



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

Bishop François forms New Vocation Team

The goal is to create a "Culture of Service & Vocations" within the Melkite Catholic Church

As Bishop François Beyrouti begins his episcopal ministry, he is emphasizing the Lord's invitation to "serve one another humbly in love" (Gal 5:13). In this spirit, one of his key priorities is to strengthen our focus on vocations throughout the Melkite Catholic Eparchy of Newton.

Thanks be to God, over the past few years, the Melkite Catholic Church in the United States has been blessed with many new vocations to the priesthood and diaconate. Looking toward the future, we can also see that many parishes have aging clergy who have been faithfully serving for so many years. Thus, there is a serious need to ensure uninterrupted pastoral care for our 50 churches and communities and to respond to the needs of our faithful who are asking us to establish new parishes.

Thus Bishop François has convened a new Vocation Team, headed by Fr. John Mefrige and composed of four other priests from each region of the eparchy. The challenge for the team is threefold.

The first task is to re-organize our efforts, both by standardizing the formation of priests and deacons, as well as establishing a clear process for men to discern God's call.

Secondly, Bishop François' vision is that new vocations will flow organically from active ministry in local parishes. Put simply, the men who will one day serve as priests and deacons must now be serving generously in other capacities. A campaign is planned to identify these men—both single and married—and invite them to discern a potential role as reader, subdeacon, deacon, or priest.



Finally, the Vocation Team aims to dramatically improve communications about vocations within the eparchy. For example, the Melkite Catholic community in the United States needs to see the joys of married clergy with families, as well as the blessing of men who serve celibately or enter monastic life. We have a number of digital and print projects planned for 2023 and beyond.

In summary, the Vocation Team is preparing to enter a multi-year process of organizing, inviting, and communicating a "pro-vocations" message throughout the eparchy. The overall vision is to build upon the core message that *Christ calls all to serve*—in all sorts of capacities—to make us a true *ecclesia*, a living Church. Every vocation is vital, including marriage and family, nuns, monks, and the clergy who lead our liturgical worship.

Clergy & Candidate Databases


One essential task is to update the biographical information of all our clergy. This will help Bishop François to review the assignments of each deacon and priest and plan for future transitions and retirements. For example, simply knowing the birth dates of all priests allows us to project retirement dates and estimate how many new men we need in formation to serve our growing communities. Similarly, our Vocation Team is streamlining the way we keep track of prospects with a new database of candidates.



2023-2024

Standardizing the Application & Formation Process

We have had a wealth of excellent candidates, but their paths to ordination have been widely varied. Our plan is to standardize the entire process, for both priests and deacons, beginning with a new, more rigorous application process, and continuing with well-defined tracks for both married and celibate seminarians.



Invitation

Becoming Fishers of Men

A call to deeper service is always a call from Christ himself. Experience shows, however, that the call is most often mediated by parish priests. Over the next three years, the role of priests as "inviters" will be a recurring theme in our regular Clergy meetings and annual Clergy Conference. We will also be sending resources to equip priests to be mentors to men in their parishes. The goal is to encourage priests to be true "fishers of men."





FALL 2023

Called by Name † Will You Help Identify Future Clergy?

Perhaps the most exciting part of our Vocation Plan is a campaign to identify candidates for readers, subdeacons, deacons, and priests. "Called by Name" will be an eparchy-wide process in which clergy and laity can submit the names of men in our parishes who may

be called to these ministries. Importantly, candidates should be longstanding, faithful members who have demonstrated stability of life and a heart for service. As Jesus told us: "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you" (John 13:14-15).

WINTER 2023-2024

Online Discernment Meetings

Men who are submitted in the Called by Name campaign will be invited to begin the discernment process through a series of online meetings with Bishop François and the Vocation Team. The purpose is to open dialogue and offer guidance for listening to God's call.

SPRING 2024

Discernment Retreat

Those who have faithfully participated in the online meetings will be invited to an in-person Discernment Retreat. This is an opportunity for talks, personal prayer, and Liturgical Prayer. The goal is that after the retreat, we will have a good sense of the next cohort of men who will advance into formation, either toward diaconate or priesthood.

Twice a year, in Spring and Fall, the Vocations Team will prepare resources for parishes to place special emphasis on vocations, by preaching as well as in children's catechesis and youth ministry. This will align with the readings and Feast days in our Melkite Catholic liturgical calendar.

We will include robust vocation pages on the Melkite Catholic Eparchy of Newton's website, Melkite.org. This will refresh our online presence, and provide a platform for our Called by Name program and other Vocation resources.

Other Communication Efforts

In Year Two of our Vocation Plan, we would like to re-energize our social media presence, specifically with a series of videos on priests, deacons, and seminarians. We will also work on an e-newsletter with tips and encouragement for young people to live out their baptism and discern their vocations
