# Epistle Acts of the Apostles 20:16-18, 28-36, SIXTH SUNDAY SUNDAY OF THE HOLY FATHERS PROKIMENON (Tone 7) Daniel 3:26, 27

Blessed are You, O Lord God of our fathers, and Your name is worthy of praise and glorious forever.

Stichon: For You are just in all You have done to us, and all Your works are true and Your ways right.

READING from the Acts of the Apostles:

In those days Paul decided to sail past Ephesus so as not to waste time in Asia. For he was hurrying as much as he could in order to reach Jerusalem for the day of Pentecost. From Miletus, however, he had sent an invitation to Ephesus for the presbyters of the church. And when they had come to him, he said to them, (20:28) "Be careful about yourselves and the whole flock over which the Holy Spirit has placed you as bishops, to herd the Church of God which He has redeemed through His own blood. For I know this, that after I am gone fierce wolves will get in among you and will not spare the flock. And from among you, some men will rise, speaking perverse doctrines, to draw away the disciples after them. "Watch, therefore, and remember that for three years, night and day, I did not cease to warn with tears every one of you. And now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the Word of His grace, Who is able to edify and to grant you an inheritance among all His blessed ones. "I have coveted no one's silver or gold or clothing. You, yourselves, know these hands of mine have provided for my needs and those of my companions. In all things, I have shown you that by working in this way you should help the weak, and remember that the Lord Jesus said in person, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" And after saying this, he knelt down and prayed with them all.

Glorify Your Son, that Your Son may glorify You, even as You have given Him power over all flesh, in order that to all You have given Him, He may give everlasting life. Now this is everlasting life, that they may know You, the only true God, and the One You have sent, Jesus Christ. I have glorified You on earth; I have accomplished the work You have given Me to do. And now do You, Father, glorify Me with Yourself, with the glory that I had with You before the world existed. I have manifested Your name to the men You have given me out of the world. They were Yours, and You have given them to Me, and they have kept Your word. Now they have learned that whatever You have given Me is from You; because the words that You have given Me, I have given to them. And they have received them, and have known as a fact that I came forth from You, and they have believed that You did send Me. # LITURGY OR MASS INTENTIONS



Mass intentions can be scheduled for those who have died, and on the occasion of a birthday, wedding anniversary, for healing for the conversion of sinners, for the grace to face the challenges in life, for the success in a new job, for those serving in the church and country in different levels, for good weather, bountiful harvest, for world peace, in thanksgiving for the blessings received, etc. You can find so many reasons to think about a Mass offering. We offer the Mass for a

specific intention because we believe in the immense spiritual value of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

The custom of giving offering to have Liturgies said for specific intentions is a laudable one and should be maintained as much as possible. Church teaching and Canon Law (nos. 942-958) provide important guidelines on how to preserve the dignity and appreciation of this practice. Overall, it should be well noted that Liturgy offerings are never to be viewed as a means of parish fundraising.

<u>COMMEMORATIONS OF THE DEAD</u>: The Apostolic Constitutions refer to the repetition of the Mass on the third, ninth and fortieth days: "Let the third day be observed in remembrance of the dead with psalms, lessons, and prayers, because Christ rose from the dead on the third day. Let the ninth day be observed in remembrance both of the living and the dead, and also the fortieth day, in accordance with mourning customs of the Israelites at the time of Moses' death.

Finally, let the anniversary day be observed in memory of the dead."

In contemporary Byzantine practice, the dead are commemorated on the ninth and fortieth days and on the anniversary of their departure from this world.

Formerly under the jurisdiction of the local Latin Ordinaries before the Exarchate was established under the leadership of the late Bishop Justin Najmy of this Parish, all Melkites have been subject to the latter since its erection in 1966. The Constitution of the Melkite Eparchy which is now a sole Diocese since 1976 still acknowledges this definitive protocol. Our parishes follow local discipline in the various customs e.g., clergy attire, stipends (Mass Offerings), etc. except in Liturgy and Ritual. Our relationship with the local Latin Dioceses and Latin pastors must be permeated with a spirit of love and friendship and cooperation.

Effective January 1, 2008, which by-passed us, the schedule of offerings for Masses in parishes is now \$25.00; Funerals: \$300.00; Weddings: \$300.00.

Canon Law prohibits accepting stipends or offerings for Masses more than one year in advance (rolling calendar) Canon 953. The time within which Masses must be celebrated (1 year) begins the day the intention is received (Canon 955 #2.)

May the memories of our beloved deceased be eternal and many thanks for your understanding and undivided attention in regard to these guidelines and restrictions.

of the Ascension celebrates one aspect of the Resurrection, namely Jesus' exaltation. Jesus did not wait 40 days to be glorified at God's right hand. That had already happened at his Resurrection. The focus of this feast is the Heavenly reign of Christ. The Lord is now "seated at the right hand of the Father" as we profess in the Nicene Creed, meaning He alone is in control of the continuing plan of salvation through the Holy Spirit, unrestricted by time, space or culture. Thus, in the Paschal Mystery, Jesus' passion, death, Resurrection, Ascension and the sending of the Holy Spirit form one unbroken reality which is to be understood by Faith. The Ascension means that Jesus, His salvific suffering for our Salvation completed, is with his Father in glory. Being seated at the right hand of the Father is the fulfillment of "the prophet Daniel's vision concerning the Son of Man: 'To him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed"

Life messages:

- 1) We need to be proclaimers and evangelizers: In today's Gospel, Jesus gives this mission to all the believers: "Go out to the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature." This mission is not given to a select few but to all believers. To be a Christian is to be a proclaimer and an evangelizer. There is a difference between preaching and proclaiming. "We preach with words but we proclaim with our lives." As we celebrate the Lord's return to His Father in Heaven - His Ascension -- we are being commissioned to go forth and proclaim the Gospel of life and love, of hope and peace, by the witness of our lives. On this day of hope, encouragement and commissioning, let us renew our commitment to be true disciples everywhere we go, beginning with our family and our parish, "living in a manner worthy of the call [we] have received."
- 2) We need to live a life of Christian joy in the presence of the ascended Lord. According to Luke, the disciples "returned to Jerusalem with great joy." Apparently Jesus' exaltation and final blessing gave them, as it gives us, the assurance that, though

- 3) We have a teaching mission: Jesus taught us lessons of Faith, Hope, forgiveness, mercy, redemption and Love. We cannot put these lessons on a shelf and ignore them. They stand before us in the person of Jesus. Although no longer visibly present in the world, Jesus is present in his words., and we must make these words real in our lives as well as in the lives of others. Christianity was meant to be a Faith in which Jesus' followers would help and care for others, just as Jesus had done. But the spreading of the Good News to all nations is not a goal that can be attained by human might and craft. This is why Jesus promises to empower the Church with His abiding presence and that of the Holy Spirit. The challenge of sharing the Good News with all mankind should, therefore, begin with our admission that we have often been arrogant and overbearing. We must learn to be humble and let the Holy Spirit lead the way.
- 4) The ascended Jesus is our source of strength and encouragement: Perhaps some of the nagging doubts which inevitably accompany the journey of Faith could be lessened by our meditating on the Ascension and its implications. When we are too far from Faith to pray on our own, let us remember that we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the Righteous, praying for us. When the trials of life feel too heavy to bear, we must remember that Christ will come again in glory, the same glory in which Jesus arose from the tomb, the same glory to which Jesus ascended, and the same glory in which Jesus currently abides. Though our limited perception might find him absent, Jesus is fully present, participating in every moment of our lives. By His Ascension, Christ has not deserted us but has made it possible for the Holy Spirit to enter all times and places. In this way it is possible for each of us to be transformed by the power of the Spirit into agents or instruments of Christ. We become enlivened, and our actions become animated in a new way by the Spirit of the God we love and serve. We have become other Christs in the world

# ما معنى عيد الصعود وكيف نعيشه؟

في خميس الصَّغُود نُعيَّدُ لصعود رِينا وإلهنا ومخلصنا يسوع المسيح إلى السمّاء، وذلك بعد أربَّعين يومَّـا من قيامَتِه وظهوره للتّلاميد. "فيسوع هذا الَّذي رُفِعَ عَنكُم إلى السَّماء سَيأتي كما رأيتُموه ذاهبًا إلى السَّماء" (اعمال 1:11). صعد يسوع الى السماء وعاد الني ملكوته (يوحنا 18: 36) بعد أن أتمَّ عمل الفداء وأكمل خطة الخلاص. فالصُّغُودَ خاتمة عيد قيامة المسيح وحياته على الأرض. وهذا ما نعبر عنه في قانون الإيمان: لقد صُلبِ عنًا على عهد بيلاطس البنطي، تألُّم وِماتِ وقبر وقام في اليوم التَّالث، كما في الكتب، وصعد إلى السّماء وجلس عن يمين الأب، وأيضا سيأتي بمجد عظيم. ومن هنا نسأل ما هي ابعاد عيد الصُعُود وكِيف نعيشه ؟ يمكننا أن نميّز ثلاثة أبعاد للصعود على صعيد المسيح والكنيسة وصعيدنا.



(1الصَّعُود تمجيد المسيح السماوي إن المسيح قبل أن يعيش على الأرض يمكن القول إنه كان لدى الله كابن، و"كلمة"، وحكمة. فصعوده إلى السماء إلى يمين الأب إنما هو عودة إلى العالم السماوي الذي منه سبق ونزل من السماء، مسكن الألوهية (رؤيا 1: 5) رحمة بنا ليفتقد الناس (مزمور 144.5). بالصَّعُود والنزول ارتبطت السماء بالأرض (يوحنا 1: 51). واما جلوس يسوع عن يمين الله فيعني أنه قد أكمل عمله وأن له سلطاناً وقد توّج ملكاً. والتالي ما صعوده الا تعبير عن مجد المسيح السماوي (أعمال 2: 34).

ومن ناحية أخرى يشير صعود المسيح الى الدخول النهائي لناسوت يسوع الى مقر الله السماوي من حيث سيعود، ويخفيه هذا المقر في هذا الوقت عن عيون البشر. (ت ك 665). وفي الليتورجيا السريانية نجد هذه الصلاة التي تعبّر عن تمجيد المسيح بصعود الى السماء: "نزل ربّنا بحثًا عن آدم وبعد أن وجد من كان ضائعًا، حمله على كتفيه وبالمجد أدخله السماوات معه (لوقا 15: 4). أتى وأظهر لنا أنّه الله؛ ولبس جسدًا وكشف لنا أنّه إنسان. نزل إلى الجحيم وبيّن لنا أنّه مات؛ صعد وتمجّد وأظهر لنا أنّه كبير. فليتبارك مجده!".

(2 لصَّعُود دلالة على تسامي المسيح يدل صعود بسوع الى السماء على تساميه على الكون والقوات السماوية كما جاء في تعليم بولس السول" ثُمَّ يَكُونُ المُنتَهى جِينَ يُسَلِّمُ المُلْكَ إلى الله الآب بَحداً أن يكونَ قد أَبادَ كُلَّ رِناسةٍ وسُلطانٍ وقُوَّة "(1 قورنتس 15: 24). وكما قال النبي: "أيّها الرَّبُ سَيُدُنا ما أعظمَ أسمَكَ في الأرضِ كُلِّها! لأعَظِّمَنْ جَلاَلُكَ فَوقَ السَّمُوات" (مزمور 8: 2).

ويسوع منذ الآن يجلس على العرش في السماوات ليتقلد السيادة على الكون (أفسس 1: 20-12). ويكشف لنا انجيل متى سلطان يسوع الذي يتمتع به في السماء وعلى الأرض (متى 28: 18)، وأكد لنا بولس الرسول هذا النصر الذي اكتسبه بالصلب (كولسي 2: 15) وبطاعته (فيلبي 2: 6-11). ويقول القديس كبريانوس: "لا من لسان بشر ولا ملائكي يستطيع أن يصف كما يجب عظيم الاحتفال والاكرام الذي صار للإله المتجسد بصعوده في هذا اليوم".

(3 الصَّعُود تمهيد لعودة المسيح في مجيئه الثاني إن "يسوغ هذا الَّذي رُفِعَ عَنكُم إلى السَّماء سَياتي كما رَ أَيتُموه أَ إلى السَّماء" (أعمال 1: 11). هذه العبارة تقيم ارتباطاً عميقاً بين ارتفاع المسيح إلى السماء وبين عودته ثانية في آخر الأزمنة، عند التجديد الكلي الشامل (أعمال 3: 21) حينذلك سياتي كما انطلق (أعمال 1:11)، نازلاً من السماء (1 تسالونيقي 4: 16) على الغمام (رويا 14: 14-16)، بينما يصعد مختاروه لملاقاته، هم أيضا على عمام (1 تسالونيقي 4: 17). فالتاريخ يتحرك نحو نقطة محددة هي مجيء يسوع المسيح ثانية ليدين العالم، ويملك على كل المسكونة. وينبغي علينا، أن نكون مستعدين لمجيئه المفاجئ (1 تسالونيقي 5: 2).

#### ثانيًا: الصُّغُود على صعيد الكنيسة:

الصَّغُود على مستوى الكنيسة هو تمجيدها بحلول الروح القدس: تمجيد المسيح في صعوده كان لا بد أن يسبق تمجيد الكنيسة بحلول الروح القدس. صعد يسوع الى السماء ليرسل الروح القدس ليحلّ محلّه لدى التلاميذ كما وعد تلاميذه "الرُّوحَ القُدُسَ يَنزِلُ عَلْيكم فَتَنَالُون قُدرَةٌ وتكونُونَ لي شُهودًا في أُورَشَلِيمَ وكُلِّ اليهودِيَّةِ والسَّامِرَة، حتَّى أَفاصي الأرض (اعمال 1: 8).

صعد يسوع إلى السماء كي يرسل روحه ليحلّ محلّه لدى التلاميذ. وبحلول الروح يتحوّل الرب من كانن معنا إلى كانن فينا؛ ان كانن معنا محدودة، لكن كانن فينا غير محدودة وذلك نتيجة عمل الروح

بالإيمان" بفعل الروح القدس (أفسس 3: 17).

(1 معود يسوع ليشفع فينا في حضرة الله (عبرانيين 9: 24) تصور الرسالة إلى العبرانيين صعود المسيح في ضوء نظرتها لعالم سماوي تقوم فيه حقائق الخلاص، ونحوه تتجه

القدس. وهذا مما يؤكده القديس بولس الرسول في صلاته الى اهل أفسس: "أن

يُقيمَ المسيخُ في قُلوبِكم

في ضوء نظرتها لعالم سماوي تقوم فيه حقائق مسيرة البشر. إن الكاهن عن يمين الله كي يجلس هناك عن يمين الله (عبرانيين 1: 4-9) صحد أول الجميع، مجتازاً السماوات (عبرانيين 4: 14) يشفع فينا في حضرة الله فينا في حضرة الله (عبرانيين 9: 14) على انه

الوسيط الذي يضمن لنا فيض الروح القدوس (ت ك 667)، ويُعلق القديس أو غسطينوس" صعد يسوع الى السماء، لذلك علينا ألا نقلق على الأرض. لتكن أفكارنا هناك وسوف يكون هناك سلام. إن أردنا ان نصعد ونكون بصحبته فيجب علينا أن نكف عن الخطية وعن الشر".

#### (2 الصُّعُود لإعداد مكان لنا في السماء

يعودُ الربّ بالمجد إلى أبيه ليُعدَ لنا مكانًا (يوحنا 14: 1-3). فقد دخل يسوع أولاً تلك الحياة، ليُعدَّ لمختاريه مكاناً، ثم يأتي ويأخذهم إلى هناك ليكونوا على الدوام معه (يوحنا 14: 22). فيسوع المسيح، رأس الكنيسة، سبقنا إلى ملكوت الآب المجيد حتى نحيا نحن، أعضاء جسده، في رجاء أن نكون يوماً معه إلى الأبد (ت ك 666). إذًا فنحن لدينا ضمانة في السماء حيث سنصعد مع الرّب يسوع المسيح. وقد وعد يسوع جميع المؤمنين العاملين بوصاياه خاصة وصية المحبة بالوطن السماوي "تعالوا، يا من باركهم أبي، فرثوا الملكوت المُعدَّ لَكُم مَنذُ إنشاءِ العَالَم" (متى 25: 12). وهذا الامر يدعونا ان نترتَم مع صلاة قداس الصّعُود: "ليغمَّ السرورُ قلوبَنا، لأنَ صعود ابنك إلى السماء، هو عنوان رفعتنا، إذ مسكنه الأن سيكون مسكننا الحقيقي الأخير"؛ ويُعلق القديس أو غسطينوس:" إلهي، إنك صنعتنا لأجلك. لذلك يبقي قلبنا مضطربًا قلقًا عديم الراحة على الدوام حتى يستريح بك".

#### رابعًا: كيف نعيش روحانية عيد الصُّعُود؟

من ابعاد عيد الصّعُود تنبع روحانية الصّعُود متكاملة، مؤسسة على الرجاء، لأنها تجعل المسيحي يحيا منذ الآن في حقيقة العالم الجديد الذي يملك المسيح فيه. إن على المسيحيين و هم في انتظار تلك الساعة، أن يظلوا متحدين بفضل الإيمان وأسرار الكنيسة، بسيدهم المُمجّد. فعليهم ان يسعوا "إلى الأمور التي في العلى حَيثُ المسيح قد جَلَسَ عن يَمين الله"، لأن "حَياتُهم مُحتَجبةٌ معَ المسيح" (قولسي 3: 1-3)، ومدينتهم كاننة في السماوات (فيلبي 3: 20). والبيت السماوي ينتظر هم (2 قورنتس 5: 31)، "الإنسان السماوي" (1 قورنتس 15: 49-49). على أن المسيحي ليس لذلك أن يكون منسلخاً عن العالم، بل له رسالة على أن يحيا فيه بطريقة جديدة، تحرك العالم نحو المجد الذي يدعوه الله إليه. وهذ الامر يذكرنا على أن يحيا فيه بطريقة المناعر أبو القاسم الشّابي "من يتهيّب صعود الجبال يَعش أبَد الدُّهر بيـن الحداء الخياة" للشاعر أبو القاسم الشّابي "من يتهيّب صعود الجبال يَعش أبَد الدُّهر بيـن الحداء والخوف والرعب والأوبئة والمعاناة على الارض ليس لها الكلمة الاخيرة. سيعود يسوع بالمجد والبهاء ويُضفي سيطرة على ممالك هذا العالم.

الصَّغُود عيد يسوع نعترف به مسيحاً، نعترف به رباً ارتفع ليجتنب الجميع ويصل كلمته الى العالم كله ومن هنا علينا ان نتابع كرازة الانجيل كما اوصانا الرب "إِنِّي أُوليتُ كُلُّ سُلطانٍ في السَّماءِ والأَرض، فاذهبوا وتَلْمِذوا جَمِيع الأُمَم، وعَمِّدوهم باسْم الآب والابْن والرُّوحَ القُدُس، وعَلِموهم أَن يَحقَظوا كُلُّ ما أُوصَيتُكُم به، وهاءنذا معكم طُوالَ الأيَّامِ إلى نِهايةِ العالَم" (متى 28: 18-20). التلاميذ لم يعيشوا كل الأيام في حين الكنيسة تدوم إلى الأبد (أعمال 1: 4-9).

وعلينا ان نعلن انتظارنا لمجيئه الثاني. إنه سيأتي كما صعد، لذلك انتظار مجيء المسيح عقيدة "وننتظر قيامة الأموات وحياة الدهر الآتي آمين" ومع الليتورجيا السريانيّة نردد "يوم ولادته، فرحت مريم؛ يوم مماته، تزلزلت الأرض. يوم قيامته، تزعزعت ظلمات الجحيم؛ يوم صعوده، اغتبطت السماوات. فليتبارك صعوده"، والقديس أبيفانيوس يقول: أن هذا اليوم هو مجد بقية الأعياد وشرفها لأنه يتضح أن الرب أكمل في هذا العيد عمل الراعي العظيم (لوقا 15: 4-7).

## Jesus Ascends into Heaven!



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

#### Wear a mask that protects you and others

Wearing a face covering in public places helps protect you and anyone near you from COVID-19. Your mask should fit snugly but comfortably over your nose, mouth, and chin without any gaps.



#### RECOMMENDED

- Face mask worn the right way and at least two layers thick
- \* N-95 respirators are critical supplies that should be reserved for healthcare providers and other first responders



#### NOT RECOMMENDED

- Face shield alone
- Loose-fitting bandana
- Face mask with valve
- Face mask worn the wrong way
- Neck gaiter only one layer thick
