Kondakion of Pascha

Though You went down in the tomb, O immortal One, You overthrew the power of Hades and rose victorious, O Christ God. You greeted the ointment bearing women, saying "Rejoice!" You gave peace to Your apostles, and to those who had Fallen resurrection.

The Epistle: Acts of the Apostles: 1: 1-9

PROKIMENON (Tone 8) Ps.117: 24, 1'

This is the day the Lord has made: let us be glad and rejoice in it! Stichon: Give praise to the Lord, for he is good, for his mercy endures forever.

READING from the Acts of the Apostles

In the preceding book, Theophilus, I was concerned with everything Jesus did and taught from the beginning, until the day he was taken up, after giving commandments through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. To them also he showed himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about God's kingdom. And while eating with them, he told them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for the Father's promise, "of which you have heard," he said, "by my mouth. For while John baptized with water, you shall be baptized in the Holy Spirit within a few days."

Now, those gathered there questioned him, asking, "Lord, is it now that you will restore the kingdom to Israel?" But he answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or the proper moments the Father has set by his own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you shall be witnesses to me in Jerusalem, and in Judea and Samaria, and even to the very ends of the earth."

ALLELUIA (Tone 4)

You shall arise and have mercy upon Sion, for the time to pity her, the right time has come.

Stichon: The Lord has looked down from heaven upon all the sons of men.

Gospel of Pascha: John 1: 1-17 (In the beginning was the Word)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God; and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was made nothing that has been made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness; and the darkness grasped it not. There was a man, one sent from God, whose name was John. This man came as a witness, to bear witness concerning the light, that all might believe through him. He was not himself the light, but was to bear witness to the light. It was the true light that enlightens every man who comes into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through him, and the world knew him not. He came to his own, and his own received him not. But to as many as received him he gave the power of becoming children of God; to those who believe in his name: who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelled among us. And we saw his glory (glory as of the only-begotten of the Father) full of grace and of truth. John bore witness concerning him, and cried, "This was the one of whom I said, 'He who is to come after me has been set above me, because he was before me." And of his fullness we have all received, grace for grace. For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Please be advised that the weekly bulletin has not been printed due to the COVID-19 guidelines and restrictions, but presently, information is available online, church Facebook page and on YouTube.

<u>GENERAL HOME VISITATIONS, SICK CALLS, HOSPITAL VISITS:</u> Father Ephrem has been fully vaccinated and is now available for these parish services. Just email him at <u>office@stbasilthegreatchurch.com</u> and leave him your message. **PLEASE! NO GRATUITIES!** A cup of coffee or tea is just fine. He looks forward to in-person contact.

Canon Law prohibits accepting stipends or offerings for Liturgies more than one year in advance (rolling calendar) Canon 953. The time within which Liturgies must be celebrated (1 year) begins the day the intention is received. (Canon 955 #2). Formerly under the jurisdiction of the local Latin Ordinaries before the Exarchate was established under the leadership of the late Bishiop Justin Najmy of this Parish, all Melkites have been subject to the latter since its erection in 1966. The Constitution of the Melkite Eparchy which is now a sole Diocese since 1976 still acknowledges this definitive protocol. Our parishes follow local discipline in the various customs e.g. every day clergy attire, stipends (Liturgy Offerings), etc. except in Liturgy and Ritual. Our relationship with the local Latin Dioceses and Latin pastors must be permeated with a spirit of love and friendship and cooperation.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Presently effective, the schedule of offerings in the parishes is now: Liturgies: \$25.00; Funeral: \$300.00; Weddings: \$300.00; Baptisms: \$100.00.

Thus far, all Liturgy Offerings received from Funerals, which exceeded more than one year or even more, have had the maximum and minimum celebrations. Surplus ones have been deposited in the Building Fund, and placed on the altar and remembered collectively, similar to the customs of Spiritual Bouquets, Perpetual Mass Enrollments & Memorial Cards, as in Chapels, Shrines, & Monasteries.

May the memories of our beloved deceased rest in peace & be eternal. Many thanks for your understanding and undivided attention in regard to these canonical guidelines and restrictions.

- قيامة يسوع تكملة عمل الفداء

بدأ يسوع عمل الفداء بالتجسد والالام والصلب والموت وأكمله بالقيامة. أنقذنا الربّ يسوع من الخطايا، وبقيامته أعاد كلّ ما فقدناه من خلال الخطيئة وفتح لنا أبواب الحياة الأبديّة كما جاء في تعليم بولس الرسول " أُسلِمَ إلى المَوتِ مِن أَجْلّ زَلاَّتِنا وأَقيمَ مِن أَجْلِ بِرِّنا." (رومة 4، 25). فإن كان قد ذُبح لأجلنا، فقيامته تؤكد قبول الذبيحة. وإن كان قد صُلب من أجل ديون ذنوبنا، فقيامته تعلن وفاء الدين. وعلّق القديس ميليتيون أسقف سردينيا" اتخذَ الربُّ، معَ كونِه إلهًا، طبيعةً الإنسان، وتألُّمَ عمَّن كانَ يتألُّمُ. وقُيِّدَ بدلَ مَن كانَ مُقيَّدًا، وحُكِمَ عليه بدلَ مَن كانَ مُجرِمًا، ودُفِنَ بدلَ مَن كانَ مدفونًا، وقامَ من بينِ الأموات.

- قيامة يسوع طريق للمجد

دخل يسوع الى المجد من خلال قيامته. فعندما

كان يسوع على الارض لم يظهر مجده الا ببعض العلامات "جاءَ إلى بَيتِه. فما قَبِلَه أَهْلُ بَيتِه. (يوحنا 1: 11)، وفي لحظات قصيرة كلحظة التجلي " مضى. يسوعُ بِبُطرُسَ ويعقوبَ ويوحَنَّا فانفَرَدَ بِهِم وَحدَهم على جَبَلِ عالٍ، وتَجَلَّى بِمَرَّأَى منهم." (مرقس 9: 2)؛ اما بعد القيامة دخل يسوع عالم جديد تنبأ عنه اشعيا النبي (اشعيا 65: 17) وأصبح " رَبَّ المَجْد"(1 قورنتس 2: 8). إنّ جسده الآن مُمجِّداً، خالداً وغير قابل للتدمير. يُشارك جسد المسيح الربّ في المجد الذي كان لديه من البداية، عندما كان حاضراً مع الآب قبل الخلق. وبهذه القيامة، أثبت المسيح الربّ مجد ألوهيّته. لم يُقيمه أيّ أحد بل إنّه قام بقوّته الذاتيّة. قال الربّ يسوع: " أَبذِلُ نَفْسي لأَنالَها ثانِيّةً ما مِن أَحَدٍ يَنتزِعُها مِنّي بلَ إِنِّي أَبِذِلُها بِرِضَايَ. فَلَى أَن أَبِذِلَها ولى أَن أَنالَها ثانِيَةً" (يوحنّا 10، 18-19).

حققت القيامة وعد رفع يسوع ممجدا الى يمين الله "فداودُ لم يَصعَدْ إلى السَّموات، وهُو نَفْسُه مع ذلك يَقول: قالَ الرَّبُّ لِرَبِيِّ: اِجلِسْ عن يَميني" (اعمال الرسلِ 2: 34) كما حققت القيامة تمجيد عبد الرب "لِيَجرِيَ الشِّفاءُ والآياتُ والأَعاجيبُ بِاسمِ عَبدِكَ القُدُّوسِ يَسوع" (اعمال الرسل 4:30) كما حققت القيامة ايضا الوعد بجلوس يسوع عن يمين الله "ها إِنِّي أَرى السَّمواتِ مُتَفَتِّحَة، وابنَ الإِنسانِ قائِمًا عن يَمين الله" (اعمال الرسل 7: 56).

- القيامة هي مركز الكرازة الرسولية

وتقوم كرازة الرسل على ان يسوع قد صلب ومات، الا ان الله اقامه، وبه يُقدِّم للناس الخلاص كما صرَّح بطرس الرسول "فَتَلتُم سيِّدَ الحَياة، فأقامَه اللهُ مِن بَينِ الأَموات، ونَحنُ شُهودٌ على ذلكَّ" (اعمال الرسل 3: 14-15). ويؤكِّد لنا بولس الرسول ايضًا إيمان الجماعة الأولى بالقيامة، حيث يقول "سَلَّمتُ إِلَيكم قبلَ كُلِّ شيَءٍ ما تَسَلَّمتُه أَنا أَيضًا، وهو أَنَّ المسيحَ ماتَ مِن أَجْل خَطايانا كما وَرَدَ فِي الكُتُب، وَأَنَّه قَبِرَ وقامَ فِي اليَومِ الثِّالِثِ كما وَرَدَ فِي الكُّتُب" (1 قورنتس 15: 3-4). "وإن كانَ المسيخُ لَّم يَقُمْ، فتَبشيرُناً باطِلٌ وَّإِيمانُكُم أَيضًا باطِل" (1 قورنتس 14:15). وان رؤساء اليهود لم يكذبوا حقيقة القيامة بل اكتفوا بالبحت عن تفسير آخر له وذلك برشوة رجال الحرس بقولهم لهم قولوا إِنَّ تَلاميذُه جاؤوا لَيلاً فسَرقوه ونَحنُ نائمون" (متى 28: 13). ويمكننا أن نلقّب سفر الأعمال ببشارة القيامة. للجماعة المسيحية الأولى القيامة لها الأهمّية الأولى إذ بدون قيامة الربّ لما قامت



الكنيسة المسيحيّة على الإطلاق.

- القيامة هي عربون قيامتنا

قيامة المسيح هي موضوع إيماننا واساس رجائنا في القيامة في اليوم الاخير. قام يسوع باعتباره "باكورة الراقدين (1 قورنتس 15:20) وهو "أُوَّلُ القائمينَ مِن بَينِ الأموات" (أعمال الرسل 26: 23). فنحن نقوم، لان يسوع قد قام "فالِّذي أقامَ يسوعَ المسيحَ مِن بَينِ الأموات يُحْيي أيضًا أجسادَكُمُ الفانِيةَ بِرُوحِه الحالِّ فيكُم" (رومة 8: 11). ويقول الرسول بطرس أنّنا قد وُلدنا من جديد إلى رجاء حيّ عِن طريق قيامة يسوع المسيح من الموت "تَبارَكَ اللَّهُ أَبو ربِّنا يسوعَ المسيح، شَمَلَنا بوافِر رَحمَتِه فوَلدَنا ثانِيَةً لِرَجاءٍ حَيٍّ بقِيامَةِ يسوعَ المسيح مِن بَينِ الأموات" (1 بطرس 1، 3). ويصرّب بولس اَلرسول " نَنتَظِرُ مَجِيءَ المُخلِّصِ الرَّبِّ يسوعَ المسيح الَّذي سيُغَيِّرُ هَيئَةَ جَسَدِنا الحَقيرِ فيَجعَلُه على صُورةِ جَسَدِه المَجيد بما لَه مِن قُدرَةٍ يُخضِعُ بِها لِنَفْسِه كُلَّ شَيَء" (فيلبي 3: 21).

موقفنا تجاه القيامة

بعدما بحثنا في معانى قيامة المسيح يكشف يوحنا الإنجيلي عن مراحل نرتقي بها إلى معرفة القيامة وفهمها من خلال الانتقال من رؤية مريم المجدلية السطحية،

الى نظرة بطرس التحليلية، الرؤية التلميذ الحبيب وإيمانه. فمن خلال خبرة الرسل يمكن ان يتخذ المرء اربعة مراحل ليصل الى الايمان بقيامة يسوع من الاموات:

المرحلة الاولى: التساؤل

قد يظن المرء ان القيامة مجرد تلفيق يُستحال تصديقه او فكرة إمكانية خطف الجثة كما كان الحال مع مريم المجدلية التي تساءلت امام القبر الفارغ " أَخَذُوا الرَّبُّ مِنَ القَبْرِ، ولا نَعلَمُ أينَ وَضَعوه"" (يوحنا 20: 2). فقد رأت مريم المجدلية كما يرى كل إنسان بحاسة النظر ولم تفقه بعد سبب القبر الفارغ ولم تدخل اليه. والجدير بالذكر ان انجيل يوحنا أشار بان مريم المجدلية كانت وحدها عند القبر دون ذكر سائر النسوة، لأنها مثل توما ترمز الى الذين يحتاجون الى ان يروا لكي

تقوم المرحلة الثانية بتحقق المرء من الحقائق كما هو الحال مع بطرس ويوحنا "دَخَلَ القَبْرَ فأَبصَرَ. اللَّفائِفَ مَمْدودة" (20: 6) رأى بطرس الاكفان مرتّبة في مكانها على الارض واستدل مِن كل ما رأى ان جسد يسوع قد تحرر من اللفائف والمنديل ولكنه ظِلَّ مذهولا من حدث القيامة؛ بطرس رأى وتعجب كما يصفه لوقا الإنجيلي "غيرَ أَنَّ بُطرُسَ قام فأُسرَعَ إلى القَبْرِ وانحِنَى، فلَم يَرَ إِلَّا اللَّفائِف، فَانصَرَفَ إِلَى بَيتِه مُتَعَجِّباً مِمَّا جَرى" (لوقا 24: 12)، اما يوحنا الحبيب "فِرأَى وآمَنَ" (يوحنا 20: 8). فهم يوحنا فورا لغة القبر الفارغ، والاكفان الممدودة، والمنديل ملفوفا على حدة. فهذه التفاصيل تنفي سرقة الجسد. فآمن بقيامة الرب. وعلى إيمان الرسل ثبت إيمان الكنيسة. وليس الإيمان تصديق الأشياء الَّتي تتناقض مع العقل، بل هو فوق وما وراء العقلِ كما جاء في تعليم صاحب الرسالة الى العبرانيين "فالإِيمانُ قِوامُ الأَمورِ الَّتِي تُرْجِي وبُرْهانُ الحَقائِقِ الَّتِي لا تُرى" (عبرانيّين 11، 1). إنّ أساس الإيمان المسيحي هو أحداثاً جرت بالفعل، من شهادة شهود عيان جديرين بالثقة.

يسوع المسيح هو شخصيا "القِيامةُ والحَياة مَن آمَنَ بِي، وَإِن ماتَ، فسَيَحْيا" (يوحنا 11: 25). وهو يُشركنا منذ الآن في الحياة الجديدة عن طريق علامات اسرار الكنيسة. فالحياة الجديدة التي دخلنا فيها ليست شيئا آخر سوى حياته ذاتها كشخص قام من بين الاموات "مع أنَّنا كُنَّا أَمواتًا بِزَلاَّتِناً، أَحْيانا مع المَسيح (بِالنِّعمةِ نِلتُمُ الخَلاص) وأقامَنا معه وأجلَسَنا معه في السَّمَواتِ في المسيح يسوع (أفسس 2: 5-6). إن ايماننا بقيامة يسوع يوجّه كل كياننا المسيحي "أُمَّا وقد قُمتُم مع المسَيح، فاسعَوا إلى الأُمورِ الَّتي في العُلى حَيثُ المسيِّحُ قد جَلَسَ عن يَمينِ الله". (قولسي 3: 1).

أيها الرب يسوع المسيح، يا من غلبت الموت وخرجت من ظلمة القبر منتصراً ونقض موتك موتنا وبقيامتك اعدت الحياة الينا، امنحنا رُّوحَك القدوس وأظهر غفرانك وسلامك وفرحك في قلوبنا وحياتنا فنشَهِد بِفَمِنا أنَّ يسوعَ رَبّ، ونؤمن بِقَلبِنا أنَّ اللّهَ أقامَه مِن بَينِ الأُموات، ونكون شُهودًا لقيامتك على مثال الرسل " فلا نَستَطيعُ السُّكوتَ عن ذِكْر ما زَأَينا وما سَمِعْنا وما اختبرنا" (اعمال الرسل 4: 21)، ونشع هذا الايمان للجميع منشدين مع الكنيسة "المسيح قام من بين الأموات ووطِئ الموت بالموت. ووهب الحياة للّذين في القبور".

The Joy of the Resurrection

"If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified of God that he raised Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:14-15). With these words Saint Paul explains quite drastically what faith in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ means for the Christian message overall: it is its very foundation. The Christian faith stands or falls with the truth of the testimony that Christ is risen from the dead.

If this were taken away, it would still be possible to piece together from the Christian tradition a series of interesting ideas about God and men, about man's being and his obligations, a kind of religious world view: but the Christian faith itself would be dead. Jesus would be a failed religious leader, who despite his failure remains great and can cause us to reflect. But he would then remain purely human, and

his authority would extend only so far as his message is of interest to us. He would no longer be a criterion; the only criterion left would be our own judgment in selecting from his heritage what strikes us as helpful. In other words, we would be alone. Our own judgment would be the highest instance.

Therefore it is necessary to listen with particular attention as the New Testament bears witness to the Resurrection. Yet first we have to acknowledge that this testimony, considered from a historical point of view, is presented to us in a particularly complex form and gives rise to many questions.

- •1) We are to be a Resurrection people: Easter, the feast of the Resurrection, gives us the joyful message that we are a "Resurrection people." This means that we are not supposed to lie buried in the tomb of our sins, evil habits and dangerous addictions. It gives us the Good News that no tomb can hold us down anymore not the tomb of despair, discouragement or doubt, nor that of death. Instead, we are expected to live a joyful and peaceful life, constantly experiencing the real presence of the Risen Lord in all the events of our lives. "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad" (Psalm 118:24).
- •2) We need to seek our peace and joy in the Risen Jesus: The living presence of the Risen Lord gives us lasting peace and celestial joy in the face of the boredom, suffering, pain and tensions of our day-to-day life. "Peace be with you!" was His salutation to His disciples at all post-Resurrection appearances. For the true Christian, every day must be an Easter Day, lived joyfully in the close company of the Risen Lord.
- •3) We are to be transparent Christians: We are called to be transparent Christians, showing others, through our lives of love, mercy, compassion and self-sacrificing service, that the Risen Jesus is living in our hearts.
- •4) We need to live new, disciplined lives in the Risen Jesus: Our awareness of the all-pervading, loving presence of the Risen Lord in and around us, and the strong conviction of our own coming



resurrection, help us control our thoughts, desires, words and behavior. These salutary thoughts inspire us to honor our bodies, keeping them holy, pure and free from evil habits and addictions. Our conviction that the Risen Lord is present in our neighbors and in all those we encounter should encourage us to respect them, and to render them loving, humble and selfless service.

•5) We need to remember Easter in our Good Fridays: Easter reminds us that every Good Friday in our lives will have an Easter Sunday and that Jesus will let us share the power of His Resurrection. Each time we display our love of others, we share in the Resurrection. Each time we face a betrayal of trust, we share in the Resurrection of Jesus. Each time we fail in our attempts to ward off temptations — but keep on trying to overcome them — we share in the Resurrection. Each time we continue

to hope – even when our hope seems unanswered – we share in the power of Jesus' Resurrection. In short, the message of Easter is that nothing can destroy us – not pain, sin, rejection or death – because Christ has conquered all these, and we too can conquer them if we put our Faith in Him.

- •6) We are to be bearers of the Good News of Resurrection power. Resurrection is Good News, but at the same time, it's sometimes painful because it involves death. Before the power of the Resurrection can take hold in our own lives, we're called to die to sin, to die to self. We may even have to die to our own dreams, so that God can do what He wants to do with our lives. Resurrection is about seeing our world in a new way. Early that Easter morning, Mary Magdalene did not find what she was looking for, the dead body of Jesus. But she found something better than she could have imagined: The Risen Jesus. Sometimes, the things we think we want most are not granted to us. What we get instead is an experience of God's new ways of working in the world. That's the power of the Resurrection. When those moments come, we must spread the news --just as Mary Magdalene did: We have seen the Lord!
- •7) We need to be Easter people: We are in truth called to be an "Easter people", because there are many Easter moments in our lives. It may be in prayer, when for a moment we really experience the love of God, especially having felt His absence, as we often do, like the disciples who experienced the emptiness of the tomb. It may be that moment when we are touched and given hope by a word of Scripture like the disciples on the road to Emmaus when their hearts were uplifted in joy and hope as the Lord opened up the scriptures to them. Or it may be a moment during the sacrament of reconciliation, after we have acknowledged honestly our weakness and selfishness, our sinfulness and come to experience his forgiveness. Indeed, there are times in our lives when we know, through Faith, that the times of calm after the storm, of joy after sorrow, of restored vitality after weary days on our journey of Faith, are truly times when we share in his paschal mystery
